

# SENATE BILL No. 680

June 25, 2009, Introduced by Senators PAPPAGEORGE, BROWN, KAHN and BIRKHOLZ and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 314a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 314A. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL, AT THE TIME A  
2 DRIVER LICENSE IS ISSUED TO OR RENEWED BY AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED  
3 IN SUBSECTION (2), PROVIDE THE INDIVIDUAL WITH WRITTEN INFORMATION  
4 IN A FORM DETERMINED APPROPRIATE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE  
5 REGARDING THE PROHIBITIONS AGAINST AND PENALTIES FOR SELLING OR  
6 FURNISHING ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO A MINOR IN VIOLATION OF SECTION 701  
7 OF THE MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE OF 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL  
8 436.1701.

1           (2) THE WRITTEN INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL  
2 BE PROVIDED TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND  
3 WHO WAS NOT PREVIOUSLY ISSUED THE INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN  
4 SUBSECTION (1) .

5           (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR" MEANS THAT  
6 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 105 OF THE MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE  
7 OF 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL 436.1105.
