A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 931a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 931A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT, EITHER DIRECTLY OR
- 2 INDIRECTLY, GIVE, LEND, OR PROMISE VALUABLE CONSIDERATION TO OR FOR
- 3 ANY PERSON AS A REWARD FOR VOTING OR REFRAINING FROM VOTING.
- 4 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT, FOR THE PERSON'S OWN BENEFIT OR ON
- 5 BEHALF OF ANY OTHER PERSON, RECEIVE, AGREE, OR CONTRACT FOR
- 6 VALUABLE CONSIDERATION FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) REGISTERING TO VOTE OR AGREEING TO REGISTER TO VOTE, OR
- INDUCING OR ATTEMPTING TO INDUCE ANOTHER PERSON TO REGISTER TO
- 9 VOTE.

- 1 (B) REFRAINING OR AGREEING TO REFRAIN, OR INDUCING OR

- 11 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,500.00, OR BOTH, FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- 12 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "VALUABLE CONSIDERATION" MEANS
- 13 THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 931.
- 14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 15 unless Senate Bill No. 693
- of the 95th Legislature is enacted into law.
