SENATE BILL No. 724

August 5, 2009, Introduced by Senators JANSEN, HUNTER, GILBERT, BIRKHOLZ, HARDIMAN and JACOBS and referred to the Committee on Families and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 11b (MCL 722.121b), as amended by 2007 PA 217.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 11b. (1) The department shall establish and maintain a database of child care centers, family child care homes, and group child care homes as a central clearinghouse for persons seeking information on child care options. The database shall include, at a minimum, all of the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of the child care center, family child care home, or group child care home.

- 1 (b) The days and general hours of operation of the child care
- 2 center, family child care home, or group child care home.
- 3 (c) The license or registration number, effective date, and
- 4 expiration date of the child care center, family child care home,
- 5 or group child care home.
- 6 (d) The number and nature of any adverse action taken against
- 7 the child care center, family child care home, or group child care
- 8 home by the department.
- 9 (2) The department shall make the database available to the
- 10 public on the internet, without charge, through that department's
- 11 website.
- 12 (3) The department shall inform the public, through press
- 13 releases or other media avenues, of the information available in
- 14 the database established under subsection (1) and how to access
- 15 that database.
- 16 (4) THE INFORMATION PROVIDED REGARDING LICENSEES OR
- 17 REGISTRANTS IN THE DATABASE SHALL COVER A 5-YEAR PERIOD FROM THE
- 18 MOST RECENT LICENSING DATE, REGISTRATION DATE, OR RENEWAL DATE.
