

SENATE BILL No. 741

August 18, 2009, Introduced by Senators ANDERSON, CLARK-COLEMAN, SCOTT, CHERRY, GLEASON, OLSHOVE, SWITALSKI, CLARKE, JACOBS, THOMAS, HUNTER, RICHARDVILLE and JELINEK and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 750 (MCL 257.750), as amended by 1988 PA 446.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 750. (1) A police officer shall not be required to issue
2 a ~~certain~~ **PREDETERMINED OR SPECIFIED** number of citations for
3 violations of this act or of local ordinances substantially
4 corresponding to provisions of this act, including parking or
5 standing violations. ~~, unless the issuance of citations is a part~~
6 ~~of a~~ **A** police officer's performance evaluation system ~~and the~~
7 ~~issuance of citations is not given any greater consideration than~~
8 ~~any other factor in the evaluation of a police officer's~~
9 ~~performance. In the absence of a police officer's performance~~

1 ~~evaluation system, the issuance of citations shall not be given any~~
2 ~~greater consideration than any other factor in the evaluation of a~~
3 ~~police officer's performance.~~ **SHALL NOT REQUIRE A PREDETERMINED OR**
4 **SPECIFIED NUMBER OF CITATIONS TO BE ISSUED.** Section 901 does not
5 apply to a violation of this subsection.

6 (2) A police officer shall not be entitled to any fees for
7 issuing a citation. A police officer, judge, district court
8 magistrate, or other person employed by the state or by a local
9 governmental unit who violates section 749 or this subsection is
10 guilty of misconduct in office and subject to removal from office.
