

# SENATE BILL No. 813

September 15, 2009, Introduced by Senators GILBERT and McMANUS and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled  
"Michigan vehicle code,"  
by amending section 811i (MCL 257.811i), as amended by 2006 PA 562.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 811i. (1) Fund-raising plate donations collected for  
2 plates recognizing the water quality of this state under section  
3 811f and collector plate fund-raising donations collected under  
4 section 811g shall be disbursed under section 811h by the secretary  
5 of state to the state treasurer, who shall credit the donation  
6 money to the water quality protection fund created under subsection  
7 (3).

8       (2) The department of ~~environmental quality~~ **NATURAL RESOURCES**

1 shall establish and administer a "water quality protection fund  
2 grant program" and shall set policy and oversee this program. The  
3 program shall provide grants to local units of government for the  
4 purpose of protecting the water quality of the Michigan Great Lakes  
5 and inland lakes, rivers, and streams. The department of  
6 ~~environmental quality~~ **NATURAL RESOURCES** may promulgate rules to  
7 implement this grant program under the administrative procedures  
8 act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328.

9 (3) The water quality protection fund is created within the  
10 state treasury. The state treasurer may receive money or other  
11 assets from any source for deposit into the fund. The state  
12 treasurer shall direct the investment of the fund. The state  
13 treasurer shall credit to the fund interest and earnings from fund  
14 investments. Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year  
15 shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.  
16 Money from the fund shall be expended, upon appropriation, only for  
17 the purpose of protecting the water quality of the Michigan Great  
18 Lakes and inland lakes, rivers, and streams.

19 (4) For purposes of this chapter, "local unit of government"  
20 means any of the following:

21 (a) A county, city, village, or township.

22 (b) An agency of a county, city, village, or township.

23 (c) The office of a county drain commissioner.

24 (d) A ~~soil~~-conservation district established under part 93 of  
25 the natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA  
26 451, MCL 324.9301 to 324.9313.

27 (e) A watershed council established under part 311 of the

1 natural resources and environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451,  
2 MCL 324.31101 to 324.31119.

3 (f) A local health department as that term is defined in  
4 section 1105 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1105.

5 (g) A community college or junior college established pursuant  
6 to section 7 of article VIII of the state constitution of 1963.

7 (h) A 4-year institution of higher education, public or  
8 private, located in this state.

9 (i) An authority or other public body created by or pursuant  
10 to state law.

11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
12 unless Senate Bill No. 807

13 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into law.
