

SENATE BILL No. 875

September 24, 2009, Introduced by Senator SWITALSKI and referred to the Committee on Senior Citizens and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to provide for a registry to notify Michigan residents who want to honor Michigan soldiers who have died in combat; and to provide for certain duties of certain state agencies.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "honoring fallen soldiers act".

3 Sec. 2. The department of military and veterans affairs shall
4 post information on the internet concerning members of the United
5 States military who are residents of this state and who have been
6 killed in combat.

7 Sec. 3. The department shall ensure that a resident of this
8 state who registers at the site, gives his or her electronic mail
9 address, and wishes to be notified through electronic mail of the

1 death of a member of the military who is a resident of this state
2 may be notified so that the member of the military may be honored
3 by the flying of a flag at half-mast or other appropriate method.
