

SENATE BILL No. 899

October 14, 2009, Introduced by Senator WHITMER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
by amending section 16o of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16o), as amended
by 2004 PA 457.
