## **SENATE BILL No. 914**

October 20, 2009, Introduced by Senator McMANUS and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 2002 PA 733, entitled "State plumbing act,"
by amending section 13 (MCL 338.3523).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 13. (1) There is created a state plumbing board within
  the department. The governor, with the advice and consent of the
  senate, shall appoint 5 THE STATE PLUMBING BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF
  THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
  - (A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES OR HIS OR HER AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, AS A VOTING EX OFFICIO MEMBER.
  - (B) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
    INVOLVED WITH DRINKING WATER AND RADIOLOGIC PROTECTION, SELECTED BY

- 1 THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AS A VOTING EX
- 2 OFFICIO MEMBER.
- 3 (C) FIVE United States citizens who are residents of the
- 4 state, 2 of whom shall be APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE
- 5 AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE AS FOLLOWS:
- 6 (i) TWO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE licensed plumbing contractors who
- 7 hold a master's license.
- 8 (ii) One shall be INDIVIDUAL WHO IS a licensed master plumber
- 9 WITH 10 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AND EXPERIENCE IN securing permits. 7
- 10 and 1 shall be
- 11 (iii) ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS a licensed journey plumber , each
- 12 having 10 years' WITH 10 YEARS OF experience. , and a person
- 13 (iv) ONE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS representative of the general
- 14 public. , who with the director of the department of environmental
- 15 quality or his or her authorized representative, a member or
- 16 employee of the drinking water and radiologic protection division
- 17 of the department of environmental quality, selected by the
- 18 director of the department of environmental quality as voting ex
- 19 officio members, shall constitute the plumbing board.
- 20 (2) Upon the expiration of the term of office of each person
- 21 so appointed by the governor to the state plumbing board under
- 22 SUBSECTION (1), the governor shall, on or before July 1 in each
- 23 year, appoint a successor to hold office for a term of 3 years.
- 24 (3) (2)—Per diem compensation of the members of the board,
- 25 other than the director and the director of the department of
- 26 environmental quality NATURAL RESOURCES or their HIS OR HER
- 27 authorized representatives and the member or employee of the

- 1 drinking water and radiologic protection division of the department
- 2 of environmental quality NATURAL RESOURCES, and the schedule for
- 3 reimbursement of expenses shall be established annually by the
- 4 legislature.
- 5 (4)  $\frac{(3)}{(3)}$  The board shall meet as often as necessary to fulfill
- 6 its duties under this act, but shall meet not less than 4 times a
- 7 year. A majority of the members appointed and serving shall
- 8 constitute a quorum. An approval, decision, or ruling of the board
- 9 does not become effective unless supported by a majority of the
- 10 members present constituting a quorum. A member of the board shall
- 11 not vote by proxy.
- 12 (5) (4) At the first meeting of each calendar year, the board
- 13 shall elect 1 member as chairperson, another as vice-chairperson,
- 14 another as secretary, and other officers as it determines
- 15 appropriate, for the terms and with the duties and powers as the
- 16 board determines. The chairperson, vice-chairperson, and secretary
- 17 shall be elected from those members appointed to the board by the
- 18 governor.
- 19 (6) (5) The business which the board may perform shall be
- 20 conducted at a public meeting of the board held in compliance with
- 21 the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275. Public
- 22 notice of the time, date, and place of the meeting shall be given
- 23 in the manner required by the open meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL
- 24 15.261 to 15.275. A member of the board who intentionally violates
- 25 this subsection is subject to the penalties prescribed in the open
- 26 meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 27 (7) (6)—A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of,

- 1 or retained by the board in the performance of an official function
- 2 shall be made available to the public in compliance with the
- 3 freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231 to 15.246. The
- 4 department shall maintain physical possession of the files of the
- 5 board and shall ensure that applicable laws concerning public
- 6 access to the files are met.
- 7 (8)  $\frac{(7)}{}$  The board shall recommend to the state construction
- 8 code commission the promulgation of rules necessary for the safe
- 9 design, construction, installation, alteration, and inspection of
- 10 plumbing. The board may also recommend to the state construction
- 11 code commission, after testing and evaluation, that it issue
- 12 certificates of acceptability under the code for a material,
- 13 product, method of manufacturing, or method of construction or
- 14 installation of plumbing equipment.
- 15 (9) (8)—The department, in consultation with the board, shall
- 16 promulgate rules pursuant to the administrative procedures act of
- 17 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328, for the administration of
- 18 this act and to effectuate the purposes of this act including, but
- 19 not limited to, the establishing of standards for license
- 20 classifications under this act; the examination and licensing of
- 21 plumbing contractors, master plumbers, and journey plumbers; and
- 22 for the registration of plumbers' apprentices. Before an
- 23 examination or other test required under this act is administered,
- 24 the board, in consultation with the department, shall review and
- 25 approve the form and content of the examination or test. Each
- 26 examination for a license as a plumbing contractor, master plumber,
- 27 or journey plumber shall be conducted by the board and the

- 1 department, acting jointly.
- 2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 3 unless Senate Bill No. 807
- 4 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into law.
