- 2 BRIDGE CARD OR OTHER FORM OF ELECTRONIC BENEFIT TRANSFER OR
 - ASSISTANCE PAYMENT TO PURCHASE LOTTERY TICKETS.
- 4 (2) NO LOTTERY RETAILER SHALL ACCEPT A MICHIGAN BRIDGE CARD OR
- 5 OTHER FORM OF ELECTRONIC BENEFIT TRANSFER OR ASSISTANCE PAYMENT FOR
- 6 THE PURCHASE OF LOTTERY TICKETS.
