A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 255.

- 4 (2) THE MIAA TASK FORCE SHALL CONSIST OF THE COMMISSIONER OF

- 6 SENATE APPOINTED BY THE SENATE MAJORITY LEADER, 1 MEMBER OF THE

- 8 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF

- 10 (10) MEMBERS OF THE MIAA TASK FORCE SHALL SERVE WITHOUT
- 11 COMPENSATION. HOWEVER, MEMBERS OF THE MIAA TASK FORCE MAY BE
- 12 REIMBURSED FOR THEIR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE

- 9 (E) COST OF MANDATORY BENEFITS.
- 10 (F) OTHER METHODS TO REDUCE AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PREMIUMS,
- 11 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, GROUP POOLING AND INSURANCE
- 12 RECIPROCAL EXCHANGES.
- 13 (13) THE MIAA TASK FORCE SHALL REPORT TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE
- 14 OF REPRESENTATIVES STANDING COMMITTEES ON INSURANCE ISSUES ON THE
- 15 EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND SHALL MAKE
- 16 FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS BASED ON THOSE EXAMINATIONS BY NOT
- 17 LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION.
