SENATE BILL No. 1085

January 21, 2010, Introduced by Senators JANSEN, HARDIMAN, BASHAM, BIRKHOLZ, VAN WOERKOM, CROPSEY, PAPPAGEORGE and GILBERT and referred to the Committee on Reforms and Restructuring.

A bill to amend 1967 (Ex Sess) PA 8, entitled

"An act to provide for intergovernmental transfers of functions and responsibilities,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 124.534).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. A contract shall include:
- 2 (a) A description of the functions or responsibilities to be
- 3 transferred.
 - (b) The effective date of the contract.
 - (c) The term of operation under the contract.
 - (d) The manner in which the affected employees, if any, of the
 - participating political subdivisions shall be transferred,
 - reassigned, or otherwise treated subject to the following:

- 1 (i) Such employees as are necessary for the operation thereof
- 2 shall be transferred to and appointed as employees subject to all
- 3 rights and benefits. These employees shall be given seniority
- 4 credits and sick leave, vacation, insurance, and pension credits in
- 5 accordance with the records or labor agreements from the acquired
- 6 system. Members and beneficiaries of any pension or retirement
- 7 system or other benefits established by the acquired system shall
- 8 continue to have rights, privileges, benefits, obligations, and
- 9 status with respect to such THE established system. The political
- 10 subdivision to which the functions or responsibilities have been
- 11 transferred shall assume the obligations of any system acquired by
- 12 it with regard to wages, salaries, hours, working conditions, sick
- 13 leave, health and welfare, and pension or retirement provisions for
- 14 employees. If the employees of an acquired system were not
- 15 guaranteed sick leave, health and welfare, and pension or
- 16 retirement pay based on seniority, the political subdivision shall
- 17 not be required to provide these benefits retroactively.
- 18 (ii) No employee who is transferred to a position with the
- 19 political subdivision shall by reason of such THAT transfer be
- 20 placed in any worse position with respect to workmen's
- 21 compensation, pension, seniority, wages, sick leave, vacation,
- 22 health and welfare insurance, or any other benefits that he OR SHE
- 23 enjoyed as an employee of such THE acquired system.
- 24 (iii) NOTHING IN THIS ACT REQUIRES THAT THE EMPLOYER PAY TO
- 25 EMPLOYEES THE HIGHEST WAGES AND BENEFITS PREVIOUSLY PAID TO ANY OF
- 26 THE EMPLOYEES OR THEIR PREEXISTING BARGAINING UNITS.
- (e) The manner in which any real property, facilities,

- 1 equipment, or other personal property required in the execution of
- 2 the contract shall be transferred, sold, or otherwise disposed of
- 3 between the contracting parties.
- 4 (f) The method of financing to be used and the amount to be
- 5 paid by each of the participating units in relation to the
- 6 undertaking involved.
- 7 (g) Other legal, financial, and administrative arrangements
- 8 necessary to effectuate the undertaking.
