## **SENATE BILL No. 1125**

February 9, 2010, Introduced by Senators GEORGE and KAHN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled
"Revised judicature act of 1961,"
by amending sections 2529 and 8371 (MCL 600.2529 and 600.8371),
section 2529 as amended by 2004 PA 205 and section 8371 as amended
by 2005 PA 151.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2529. (1) In the circuit court, the following fees shall
   be paid to the clerk of the court:
- 3 (a) Before a civil action other than an action brought
  - exclusively under section 2950, 2950a, or 2950h to 2950m is
- 5 commenced, or before the filing of an application for
  - superintending control or for an extraordinary writ, except  ${ t the A}$
  - writ of habeas corpus, the party bringing the action or filing the

- 1 application shall pay the sum A FEE of \$150.00 FOR EACH DEFENDANT
- 2 NAMED IN THE ACTION. The clerk at the end of each month shall
- 3 transmit for each fee collected under this subdivision within the
- 4 month \$31.00 to the county treasurer and the balance of the filing
- 5 fee to the state treasurer for deposit in the civil filing fee fund
- 6 created in section 171.
- 7 (b) Before the filing of a claim of appeal or motion for leave
- 8 to appeal from the district court, probate court, a municipal
- 9 court, or an administrative tribunal or agency, the sum of
- 10 APPELLANT OR MOVING PARTY SHALL PAY \$150.00. For each fee collected
- 11 under this subdivision, the clerk shall transmit \$31.00 to the
- 12 county treasurer and the balance of the fee to the state treasurer
- 13 for deposit in the civil filing fee fund created in section 171.
- 14 (c) If AT THE TIME a trial by jury is demanded, the party
- 15 making the demand at the time shall pay the sum of \$85.00. Failure
- 16 to pay the fee at the time the demand is made constitutes a waiver
- 17 of the right to a jury trial. The sum-FEE PAID shall be taxed in
- 18 favor of the party paying the fee, in case IT IF the party recovers
- 19 a judgment for costs. For each fee collected under this
- 20 subdivision, the clerk shall transmit \$25.00 to the state treasurer
- 21 for deposit in the juror compensation reimbursement fund created in
- 22 section 151d.
- 23 (d) Before entry of a final judgment or order in an action in
- 24 which the custody, support, or parenting time of minor children is
- 25 determined or modified, the party submitting the judgment or order
- 26 shall pay 1 of the following fees: , which shall be deposited by
- 27 the county treasurer as provided in section 2530:

- (i) In an action in which the custody or parenting time of
   minor children is determined, \$80.00.
- 3 (ii) In an action in which the support of minor children is
- 4 determined or modified, \$40.00. This fee does not apply when a fee
- $\mathbf{5}$  is paid under subparagraph (i). The court may order a party to
- 6 reimburse to the other party all or a portion of the fee paid by
- 7 that other party.
- 8 (e) Except as otherwise provided in this section, upon the
- 9 filing of a motion, the sum of MOVING PARTY SHALL PAY \$20.00. In
- 10 conjunction with an action brought under section 2950 or 2950a, a
- 11 motion fee shall not be collected for a motion to dismiss the
- 12 petition, a motion to modify, rescind, or terminate a personal
- 13 protection order, or a motion to show cause for a violation of a
- 14 personal protection order. A motion fee shall not be collected for
- 15 a motion to dismiss a proceeding to enforce a foreign protection
- 16 order or a motion to show cause for a violation of a foreign
- 17 protection order under sections 2950h to 2950m. A motion fee shall
- 18 not be collected for a request for a hearing to contest income
- 19 withholding under section 7 of the support and parenting time
- 20 enforcement act, 1982 PA 295, MCL 552.607. For each fee collected
- 21 under this subdivision, the clerk shall transmit \$10.00 to the
- 22 state treasurer for deposit in the state court fund created by
- 23 section 151a.
- 24 (f) For services under the direction of the court that are not
- 25 specifically provided for in this section relative to the receipt
- 26 RELATED TO RECEIVING, safekeeping, or expending of money, or the
- 27 purchasing, taking, or transferring of—a security, or the

- 1 collecting of interest on a security, the clerk shall receive A
- 2 PARTY SHALL PAY the allowance and compensation from the parties as
- 3 THAT the court may consider DETERMINES TO BE just and shall direct
- 4 by court order, AS ORDERED BY THE COURT after notice to the
- 5 parties. to be charged.
- 6 (g) Upon appeal to the court of appeals or the supreme court,
- 7 the sum of APPELLANT SHALL PAY \$25.00.
- 8 (h) The sum of APPLICANT OR REQUESTING PARTY SHALL PAY \$15.00
- 9 as a service fee for each writ of garnishment, attachment, OR
- 10 execution , or AND EACH judgment debtor discovery subpoena issued.
- 11 (2) The sums FEES paid as provided in this section shall be
- 12 held to be ARE PAYMENT in full for all clerk, entry, and judgment
- 13 fees in an action from the commencement of the action to and
- 14 including the issuance and return of the execution or other final
- 15 process, and are taxable as costs.
- 16 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the fees
- 17 PAID UNDER THIS SECTION shall be paid over to the county treasurer
- 18 as required by law.
- 19 (4) At the end of each month, the clerk shall transmit for
- 20 each fee collected under subsection (1)(d) \$10.00 to the state
- 21 treasurer for deposit in the CHILD SUPPORT BENCH WARRANT
- 22 ENFORCEMENT fund created by section 6a of the office of child
- 23 support act, 1971 PA 174, MCL 400.236a. The balance of the fee
- 24 collected under subsection (1)(d)(i) shall be paid to the county
- 25 treasurer and deposited by the county treasurer as provided under
- 26 section 2530 to be used to fund services that are not title IV-D
- 27 services. The balance of the fee collected under subsection

- $\mathbf{1}$  (1)(d)(ii) shall be paid to the county treasurer and deposited by
- 2 the county treasurer as provided under section 2530.
- 3 (5) The court shall order any of the fees prescribed in this
- 4 section waived or suspended, in whole or in part, upon a showing by
- 5 affidavit of indigency or inability to pay.
- 6 (6) If the person filing an action under subsection (1)(d) is
- 7 a public officer acting in his or her official capacity, if the
- 8 order is submitted with the initial filing as a consent order, or
- 9 other good cause is shown, the court shall order the fee under
- 10 subsection (1)(d) waived or suspended. If a fee is waived or
- 11 suspended and the action is contested, the court may require that 1
- 12 or more of the parties to the action pay the fee under subsection
- **13** (1)(d).
- 14 Sec. 8371. (1) In the district court, the fees prescribed in
- 15 this section shall be paid to the clerk of the court.
- 16 (2) Before a civil action is commenced in the district court,
- 17 the party commencing the action shall pay to the clerk the sum A
- 18 FEE of \$150.00 FOR EACH DEFENDANT NAMED IN THE ACTION if the amount
- 19 in controversy exceeds \$10,000.00. For each fee collected under
- 20 this subsection, the clerk shall transmit \$31.00 to the treasurer
- 21 of the district funding unit in which the action was commenced, and
- 22 shall transmit the balance to the state treasurer for deposit in
- 23 the civil filing fee fund created by section 171.
- 24 (3) Before a civil action is commenced in the district court,
- 25 the party commencing the action shall pay to the clerk the sum of
- 26 \$65.00 FOR EACH DEFENDANT NAMED IN THE ACTION if the amount in
- 27 controversy exceeds \$1,750.00 but does not exceed \$10,000.00. For

- 1 each fee collected under this subsection, the clerk shall transmit
- 2 \$23.00 to the treasurer of the district funding unit in which the
- 3 action was commenced, of which not less than \$5.00 shall be used by
- 4 the district funding unit to fund a drug treatment court if one is
- 5 planned, established, or operated in that judicial district. If the
- 6 entire amount attributable to the \$5.00 portion is not needed for
- 7 the operation of a drug treatment court, the balance that is not
- 8 needed for that purpose shall be used for the operation of the
- 9 district court. If a drug treatment court is not planned,
- 10 established, or operated in that judicial district, all \$23.00
- 11 shall be used for the operation of the district court. The clerk of
- 12 the district court shall transmit the balance of the filing fee to
- 13 the state treasurer for deposit in the civil filing fee fund
- 14 created by section 171.
- 15 (4) Before a civil action is commenced in the district court,
- 16 the party commencing the action shall pay to the clerk the sum A
- 17 FEE of \$45.00 FOR EACH DEFENDANT NAMED IN THE ACTION if the amount
- 18 in controversy exceeds \$600.00 but does not exceed \$1,750.00. For
- 19 each fee collected under this subsection, the clerk shall transmit
- 20 \$17.00 to the treasurer of the district funding unit in which the
- 21 action was commenced, of which not less than \$5.00 shall be used by
- 22 the district funding unit to fund a drug treatment court if one is
- 23 planned, established, or operated in that judicial district. If the
- 24 entire amount attributable to the \$5.00 portion is not needed for
- 25 the operation of a drug treatment court, the balance that is not
- 26 needed for that purpose shall be used for the operation of the
- 27 district court. If a drug treatment court is not planned,

- 1 established, or operated in that judicial district, all \$17.00
- 2 shall be used for the operation of the district court. The clerk of
- 3 the district court shall transmit the balance of the filing fee to
- 4 the state treasurer for deposit in the civil filing fee fund
- 5 created by section 171.
- 6 (5) Before a civil action is commenced in the district court,
- 7 the party commencing the action shall pay to the clerk the sum A
- 8 FEE of \$25.00 FOR EACH DEFENDANT NAMED IN THE ACTION if the amount
- 9 in controversy does not exceed \$600.00. For each fee collected
- 10 under this subsection, the clerk shall transmit \$11.00 to the
- 11 treasurer of the district funding unit in which the action was
- 12 commenced, of which not less than \$5.00 shall be used by the
- 13 district funding unit to fund a drug treatment court if one is
- 14 planned, established, or operated in that judicial district. If the
- 15 entire amount attributable to the \$5.00 portion is not needed for
- 16 the operation of a drug treatment court, the balance that is not
- 17 needed for that purpose shall be used for the operation of the
- 18 district court. If a drug treatment court is not planned,
- 19 established, or operated in that judicial district, all \$11.00
- 20 shall be used for the operation of the district court. The clerk of
- 21 the district court shall transmit the balance of the filing fee to
- 22 the state treasurer for deposit in the civil filing fee fund
- 23 created by section 171.
- 24 (6) The judge shall order payment of any statutory fees waived
- 25 or suspended if the person subject to the fee is receiving public
- 26 assistance or is determined by the court to be indigent.
- 27 (7) Neither this state nor a political subdivision of this

- 1 state shall be required to pay a filing fee in a civil infraction
- 2 action.
- 3 (8) Except for civil actions filed for relief under chapter
- 4 43, 57, or 84, if a civil action is filed for relief other than
- 5 money damages, the filing fee shall be equal to the filing fee in
- 6 actions for money damages in excess of \$1,750.00 but not in excess
- 7 of \$10,000.00 as provided in subsection (3) and shall be
- 8 transmitted in the same manner as a fee under subsection (3) is
- 9 transmitted. If a claim for money damages is joined with a claim
- 10 for relief other than money damages, the plaintiff shall pay a
- 11 supplemental filing fee in the same amount as required under
- **12** subsections (2) to (5).
- 13 (9) If AT THE TIME a trial by jury is demanded, the party
- 14 making the demand at the time shall pay the sum of \$50.00. Failure
- 15 to pay the fee at the time the demand is made constitutes a waiver
- 16 of the right to a jury trial. The sum FEE PAID shall be taxed in
- 17 favor of the party paying the fee, in case IT IF the party recovers
- 18 a judgment for costs. For each fee collected under this subsection,
- 19 the clerk shall transmit \$10.00 to the state treasurer for deposit
- 20 in the juror compensation reimbursement fund created in section
- **21** 151d.
- 22 (10) A sum of THE MOVING PARTY SHALL PAY \$20.00 shall be
- 23 assessed for all motions filed in a civil action. A motion fee
- 24 shall not be assessed in a civil infraction action. For each fee
- 25 collected under this subsection, the clerk shall transmit \$10.00 to
- 26 the state treasurer for deposit in the state court fund created in
- 27 section 151a and the balance shall be transmitted to the treasurer

- 1 of the district funding unit for the district court in the district
- 2 in which the action was commenced.
