

# SENATE BILL No. 1230

March 17, 2010, Introduced by Senators KUIPERS, GILBERT, JELINEK, RICHARDVILLE, BISHOP, CASSIS, PAPPAGEORGE, HARDIMAN and BARCIA and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to provide for remittance of certain excise taxes to this state; and to provide that those who remit the excise taxes be held harmless from penalties.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Sec. 1. All federal excise taxes on gasoline sold or used in  
2 this state and collected by producers in this state shall be  
3 remitted to the treasury of this state by the producers that  
4 collect these taxes.

5       Sec. 2. The treasury of this state shall not remit the  
6 proceeds remitted under section 1 to the United States.

7       Sec. 3. All producers shall be held harmless from any  
8 allegations of violations of any law of this state or the United  
9 States, whether civil or criminal, as a result of any actions taken

1 to comply with this act.

2       Sec. 4. As used in this act, "producer" means a refiner,  
3 compounder, blender, or dealer of gasoline selling exclusively to  
4 producers of gasoline in addition to producers of gasoline.
