A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 391a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 391A. A GENERAL NONPARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION SHALL BE
- 2 HELD IN EVERY COUNTY OF THIS STATE ON THE TUESDAY SUCCEEDING THE
- 3 FIRST MONDAY IN AUGUST BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION AT WHICH
- JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME COURT ARE ELECTED, AT WHICH TIME THE
- 5 QUALIFIED AND REGISTERED ELECTORS MAY VOTE FOR NONPARTISAN
- 6 CANDIDATES FOR THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT. IF, UPON
- THE EXPIRATION OF THE TIME FOR FILING PETITIONS OR INCUMBENCY
- B AFFIDAVITS OF CANDIDACY FOR THE PRIMARY ELECTION OF JUSTICES OF THE
- SUPREME COURT, IT APPEARS THAT THERE ARE NOT TO EXCEED TWICE THE

- 1 NUMBER OF CANDIDATES AS THERE ARE PERSONS TO BE ELECTED, THEN THE
- 2 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CERTIFY TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION
