- CANDIDATE FOR NOMINATION FOR THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME
- 6 COURT UPON THE OFFICIAL NONPARTISAN PRIMARY BALLOTS, THERE SHALL BE
- 7 FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE NOMINATING PETITIONS CONTAINING
 - THE SIGNATURES, ADDRESSES, AND DATES OF SIGNING OF A NUMBER OF

- 1 OUALIFIED AND REGISTERED ELECTORS RESIDING IN THIS STATE AS
- 2 DETERMINED UNDER SECTION 544F OR BY THE FILING OF AN AFFIDAVIT
