- 3 COMPANY IS INCORPORATED IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY, IS A SUBSIDIARY OF A
- 4 CORPORATION OR JOINT STOCK COMPANY INCORPORATED IN A FOREIGN
- 5 COUNTRY, RECEIVES ANY FINANCING FROM OR IS SUBSIDIZED IN ANY WAY BY
- 6 A SOURCE IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY, HAS A SHAREHOLDER OR INDIVIDUAL
- 7 MEMBER WHO IS NOT A UNITED STATES CITIZEN, OR HAS A CORPORATE
- 8 OFFICER WHO IS NOT A UNITED STATES CITIZEN.
