THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 55F. (1) AN OFFICER, A SHAREHOLDER, OR A MEMBER OF A
- 2 CORPORATION OR JOINT STOCK COMPANY WHO AFFIRMATIVELY CONSENTS TO AN
- 3 INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE BY THE CORPORATION OR JOINT STOCK COMPANY
- 4 THAT VIOLATES THIS ACT IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 5 \$1,000.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- 6 (2) A CORPORATION OR JOINT STOCK COMPANY SHALL ANNUALLY NOTIFY
- 7 ALL OFFICERS, SHAREHOLDERS, AND MEMBERS OF THE PENALTIES THEY MAY
- 8 BE SUBJECT TO UNDER THIS SECTION AND SECTION 55E.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 10 unless Senate Bill No. 1365
 - 11 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into law.
