

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION MMM

September 15, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Opsommer and Agema and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A joint resolution to petition the congress of the United States to call a convention to propose amendments to the constitution of the United States to require a balanced federal budget and to limit the federal government's power under the commerce clause.

1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
2 state of Michigan, That pursuant to article V of the constitution
3 of the United States, the legislature of the state of Michigan
4 petitions the congress of the United States of America, at its
5 session, to call a convention for the purpose of proposing
6 amendments to the constitution of the United States to require a
7 balanced federal budget and to limit the federal government's power
8 under the commerce clause.

1 Resolved further, That certified copies of this joint
2 resolution be transmitted by the secretary of state to the
3 president of the United States Senate, to the speaker of the United
4 States House of Representatives, and to each member of this state's
5 delegation to the congress and that printed copies be sent to each
6 house of each state legislature in the United States.
