A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4787 AS INTRODUCED JUNE 16, 2011

House Bill 4787 would amend the Emergency 9-1-1 Service Enabling Act to provide for a distribution of \$7.0 million in Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS) fee revenue to the Department of State Police for the Michigan Public Safety Communications System (MPSCS) in fiscal year (FY) 2011-12.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The FY 2011-12 State Police budget (Article XVI of Enrolled House Bill 4526) incorporates \$7.0 million in CMRS fee revenue for MPSCS costs. In FY 2009-10, \$5.0 million in such revenue was utilized to offset GF/GP funds. In FY 2010-11, that amount was increased to \$7.0 million. The distributions of fee revenue for both those years were implemented via Public Act 206 of 2010. This bill would implement the continuation of that funding arrangement for FY 2011-12.
