AN ACT to amend 1947 PA 336, entitled "An act to prohibit strikes by certain public employees; to provide review from disciplinary action with respect thereto; to provide for the mediation of grievances and the holding of elections; to declare and protect the rights and privileges of public employees; to require certain provisions in collective bargaining agreements; and to prescribe means of enforcement and penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act," (MCL 423.201 to 423.217) by adding section 1a.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 1a. The provisions of this act are subject to all of the following:

- (a) The municipal partnership act.
- (b) 1967 (Ex Sess) PA 8, MCL 124.531 to 124.536.
- (c) The urban cooperation act of 1967, 1967 (Ex Sess) PA 7, MCL 124.501 to 124.512.
- (d) 1988 PA 57, MCL 124.601 to 124.614.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless all of the following bills of the 96th Legislature are enacted into law:

- (a) Senate Bill No. 8.
- (b) House Bill No. 4309.
- (c) House Bill No. 4311.
- (d) House Bill No. 4312.

This act is ordered to take immediate effect.
