

SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 4025

A bill to amend 1933 PA 167, entitled
"General sales tax act,"
by amending section 25 (MCL 205.75), as amended by 2010 PA 160.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 25. (1) All money received and collected under this act
2 shall be deposited by the department in the state treasury to the
3 credit of the general fund, except as otherwise provided in this
4 section.

5 (2) Fifteen percent of the collections of the tax imposed at a
6 rate of 4% shall be distributed to cities, villages, and townships
7 pursuant to the Glenn Steil state revenue sharing act of 1971, 1971
8 PA 140, MCL 141.901 to 141.921.

9 (3) Sixty percent of the collections of the tax imposed at a
10 rate of 4% shall be deposited in the state school aid fund

1 established in section 11 of article IX of the state constitution
2 of 1963 and distributed as provided by law. In addition, all of the
3 collections of the tax imposed at the additional rate of 2%
4 approved by the electors March 15, 1994 shall be deposited in the
5 state school aid fund.

6 ~~(4) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 1988 and each~~
7 ~~fiscal year ending after September 30, 1988, **NOT LESS THAN 27.9%** of~~
8 ~~the 25% of the collections of the general sales tax imposed at a~~
9 ~~rate of 4% directly or indirectly on fuels sold to propel motor~~

For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 only, the amount deposited to the comprehensive transportation fund under this subdivision shall be reduced by \$5,000,000.00 and shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the general fund. For the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010 only, the amount deposited to the comprehensive transportation fund under this subdivision shall be reduced by \$5,700,000.00 and shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the general fund.~~

(5) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2013 ONLY, AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 18% OF THE COLLECTIONS OF THE TAX IMPOSED AT A RATE OF 4% UNDER THIS ACT FROM THE SALE OF MOTOR FUEL, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED IN SECTION 4 OF THE MOTOR FUEL TAX ACT, 2000 PA 403, MCL 207.1004, SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

(A) AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT TO MATCH AVAILABLE FEDERAL HIGHWAY FUNDS SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE STATE TRUNK LINE FUND CREATED IN SECTION 11 OF 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.661, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MATCHING FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY FUNDS AS THOSE FEDERAL FUNDS ARE MADE AVAILABLE TO THIS STATE, BUT NOT LESS THAN 39.1% SUBJECT TO SUBDIVISION (C).

(B) AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBDIVISION (A), ANY REMAINING BALANCE, SUBJECT TO SUBDIVISION (C), SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS:

(i) 66% TO THE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONS OF THIS STATE, WHICH DISTRIBUTION SHALL BE ADMINISTERED UNDER SECTION 12 OF 1951 PA 51, MCL 247.662.

(ii) 34% TO THE CITIES AND VILLAGES OF THIS STATE, WHICH

1 DISTRIBUTION SHALL BE ADMINISTERED UNDER SECTION 13 OF 1951 PA 51,
2 MCL 247.663.

3 (C) FUNDS DISTRIBUTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT EXCEED
4 \$100,000,000.00.

5 (6) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2013 ONLY AND
6 EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE LIMITED IN THIS SUBSECTION AFTER THE
7 ALLOCATIONS AND DISTRIBUTIONS ARE MADE PURSUANT TO SUBSECTIONS (2)
8 AND (3), AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE COLLECTIONS OF THE TAX IMPOSED AT A
9 RATE OF 4% UNDER THIS ACT FROM THE SALE AT RETAIL OF AVIATION FUEL
10 AND AVIATION PRODUCTS SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE STATE AERONAUTICS
11 FUND AND SHALL BE EXPENDED, ON APPROPRIATION, ONLY FOR THOSE
12 PURPOSES AUTHORIZED IN THE AERONAUTICS CODE OF THE STATE OF
13 MICHIGAN, 1945 PA 327, MCL 259.1 TO 259.208. NOT MORE THAN
14 \$10,000,000.00 SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE STATE AERONAUTICS FUND
15 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "STATE
16 AERONAUTICS FUND" MEANS THE STATE AERONAUTICS FUND CREATED IN
17 SECTION 34 OF THE AERONAUTICS CODE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN, 1945
18 PA 327, MCL 259.34.

19 (7) ~~(5) After the allocations and distributions are made~~
20 ~~pursuant to subsections (2) and (3), an~~ AN amount equal to the
21 collections of the tax imposed at a rate of 4% under this act from
22 the sale at retail of computer software as defined in section 1a
23 shall be deposited in the Michigan health initiative fund created
24 in section 5911 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
25 333.5911, and shall be considered in addition to, and is not
26 intended as a replacement for any other money appropriated to the
27 department of community health. The funds deposited in the Michigan

1 health initiative fund on an annual basis shall not be less than
2 \$9,000,000.00 or more than \$12,000,000.00.

3 (8) ~~(6)~~—The balance in the state general fund shall be
4 disbursed only on an appropriation or appropriations by the
5 legislature.
