- 3 license TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE, OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE
- 4 AND SURGERY, PODIATRIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY, OR DENTISTRY granted
- 5 under section 16184 is not liable in a civil action for personal
- 6 injury or death proximately caused by the professional negligence
- 7 or malpractice of the physician INDIVIDUAL in providing the care if
- 8 both of the following apply:
 - (a) The care is provided at a health facility or agency that
 - provides at least 75% of its care annually to medically indigent
