- 3 information regarding classified state employees during the
- 4 prior fiscal year:
- 5 (a) For each state department or agency:
- 6 (i) The number of full-time equivalent employees.
- 7 (ii) The average pay rate for all employees.
- 8 (iii) The average years of service for all employees.
- 9 (iv) The number of new hires, returns, and separations.
- 10 (v) The turnover rate.
- 11 (vi) The percentage of employees eligible to retire over the
- 12 next 1-, 3-, and 5-year periods.
- 13 (vii) The number of employees in each bargaining unit.
- 14 (b) The average annual cost of the benefits for all
- 15 employees.
