- 17 SANCTION OF PERMANENT REVOCATION FOR A VIOLATION OF SECTION
- 18 16221(B) (xiii) UNLESS THE VIOLATION OCCURRED WHILE THE LICENSEE OR
- 19 REGISTRANT WAS ACTING WITHIN THE HEALTH PROFESSION FOR WHICH HE
- 20 OR SHE WAS LICENSED OR REGISTERED.
