SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5196

A bill to require public employers to report information concerning public employees and severance packages for public employees; to require electronic posting of compensation information; and to require duties of certain state departments and agencies.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "public employee compensation disclosure act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of technology,
- 5 management, and budget.
- 6 (b) "Public employee" means an individual who is employed by
- 7 this state; a department or agency of this state; a city, village,
- 8 township, county, or other political subdivision of this state; a

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- school district, intermediate school district, or special district; [a
 cyber school; a public school academy;]
- 2 a community college or junior college as described in section 7 of
- 3 article VIII of the state constitution of 1963; an institution of
- 4 higher education, as described in section 4 of article VIII of the
- 5 state constitution of 1963; or any other public entity of this
- 6 state or of a political subdivision of this state.
- 7 (c) "Severance payment" means a payment that is additional
- 8 compensation paid or payable by the public employer if a public
- 9 employee's employment terminates. Severance payment does not
- 10 include a payment under a retirement plan that is generally
- 11 applicable to employees of the public employer.
- 12 Sec. 3. By June 1 of each year, a public employer shall
- 13 provide to the department or post on the public employer's website
- 14 with an access link on the public employer's homepage all of the
- 15 following information:
- 16 (a) For each job classification of the public employer in
- **17** aggregate:
- 18 (i) The number of full-time equivalent employees.
- 19 (ii) The total annual wages paid to all employees within the
- 20 job classification.
- 21 (iii) The total annual cost of the benefits for all employees
- 22 within the job classification.
- (b) For each severance payment agreement the public employer
- 24 entered into with an employee since the last reporting period, the
- 25 terms of the severance payment agreement and the employee's job
- 26 classification.
- Sec. 4. A report submitted to the department under this act

- 1 shall be submitted electronically in a format specified by the
- 2 department. The department shall post the information on a website
- 3 that is accessible to the public within 90 days after receiving the
- 4 information.
