SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 46

A bill to amend 2006 PA 110, entitled "Michigan zoning enabling act,"

(MCL 125.3101 to 125.3702) by adding section 513.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 513. (1) A BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY WITH AN ANNUAL
- 2 PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF NOT MORE THAN 100,000 GALLONS OF BIOFUEL IS
- 3 A PERMITTED USE OF PROPERTY AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO SPECIAL LAND USE
- 4 APPROVAL IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:
- 5 (A) THE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY IS LOCATED ON A FARM.
- 6 (B) THE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY IS LOCATED NOT LESS THAN
- 7 100 FEET FROM THE BOUNDARY OF ANY CONTIGUOUS PROPERTY UNDER
- 8 DIFFERENT OWNERSHIP THAN THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE BIOFUEL
- 9 PRODUCTION FACILITY IS LOCATED AND MEETS ALL APPLICABLE SETBACK

- 1 REQUIREMENTS OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE.
- 2 (C) ON AN ANNUAL BASIS, NOT LESS THAN 75% OF THE FEEDSTOCK FOR
- 3 THE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY IS PRODUCED ON THE FARM WHERE THE
- 4 BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY IS LOCATED, AND NOT LESS THAN 75% OF
- 5 THE BIOFUEL OR ANOTHER PRODUCT OR BY-PRODUCT PRODUCED BY THE
- 6 BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY IS USED ON THAT FARM.
- 7 (2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (6) AND (7), EACH OF THE FOLLOWING
- 8 IS A PERMITTED USE OF PROPERTY IF IT RECEIVES SPECIAL LAND USE
- 9 APPROVAL UNDER SUBSECTIONS (3) TO (5):
- 10 (A) A BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY WITH AN ANNUAL PRODUCTION
- 11 CAPACITY OF NOT MORE THAN 100,000 GALLONS OF BIOFUEL THAT MEETS THE
- 12 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1) (A) AND (B) BUT THAT DOES NOT MEET
- 13 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1)(C).
- 14 (B) A BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY WITH AN ANNUAL PRODUCTION
- 15 CAPACITY OF MORE THAN 100,000 GALLONS BUT NOT MORE THAN 500,000
- 16 GALLONS OF BIOFUEL THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1)(A)
- 17 AND (B).
- 18 (3) AN APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL LAND USE APPROVAL FOR A BIOFUEL
- 19 PRODUCTION FACILITY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) SHALL INCLUDE ALL
- 20 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (A) A SITE PLAN AS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 501, INCLUDING A MAP
- 22 OF THE PROPERTY AND EXISTING AND PROPOSED BUILDINGS AND OTHER
- 23 FACILITIES.
- 24 (B) A DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCESS TO BE USED TO PRODUCE
- 25 BIOFUEL.
- 26 (C) THE NUMBER OF GALLONS OF BIOFUEL ANTICIPATED TO BE
- 27 PRODUCED ANNUALLY.

- 1 (D) AN EMERGENCY ACCESS AND FIRE PROTECTION PLAN THAT HAS BEEN
- 2 REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE APPROPRIATE RESPONDING POLICE AND FIRE
- 3 DEPARTMENTS.
- 4 (E) FOR AN ETHANOL PRODUCTION FACILITY THAT WILL PRODUCE MORE
- 5 THAN 10,000 PROOF GALLONS ANNUALLY, COMPLETED UNITED STATES
- 6 DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO TAX AND TRADE
- 7 BUREAU, FORMS 5000.29 (ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION) AND 5000.30
- 8 (SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION ON WATER QUALITY CONSIDERATIONS UNDER 33
- 9 USC 1341(A)), OR SUCCESSOR FORMS, REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT REGULATIONS
- 10 UNDER THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT OF 1969, 42 USC 4321 TO
- 11 4347, AND THE FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, 33 USC 1251 TO
- 12 1387.
- 13 (F) INFORMATION THAT DEMONSTRATES THAT THE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION
- 14 FACILITY WILL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (2) AND
- 15 (5).
- 16 (G) ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTED BY THE BODY OR
- 17 OFFICIAL RESPONSIBLE FOR GRANTING SPECIAL LAND USE APPROVAL AND
- 18 RELEVANT TO COMPLIANCE WITH A ZONING ORDINANCE PROVISION DESCRIBED
- 19 IN SECTION 502(1) OR 504.
- 20 (4) A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT SHALL HOLD A HEARING ON AN
- 21 APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL LAND USE APPROVAL UNDER SUBSECTION (2) NOT
- 22 MORE THAN 60 DAYS AFTER THE APPLICATION IS FILED. FOR THE PURPOSES
- 23 OF THIS SECTION, THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 502(2) SHALL
- 24 PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE HEARING, RATHER THAN NOTICE OF A RIGHT TO
- 25 REQUEST A HEARING.
- 26 (5) SPECIAL LAND USE APPROVAL OF A BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY
- 27 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) SHALL BE MADE EXPRESSLY CONDITIONAL ON

- 1 THE FACILITY'S MEETING ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS BEFORE THE
- 2 FACILITY BEGINS OPERATION AND NO ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:
- 3 (A) BUILDINGS, FACILITIES, AND EQUIPMENT USED IN THE
- 4 PRODUCTION OR STORAGE OF BIOFUEL COMPLY WITH LOCAL, STATE, AND
- 5 FEDERAL LAWS.
- 6 (B) THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF THE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY
- 7 PROVIDES THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT WITH PROOF THAT ALL NECESSARY
- 8 APPROVALS HAVE BEEN OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
- 9 QUALITY AND OTHER STATE AND FEDERAL AGENCIES THAT ARE INVOLVED IN
- 10 PERMITTING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ASPECTS OF BIOFUEL PRODUCTION:
- 11 (i) AIR POLLUTION EMISSIONS.
- 12 (ii) TRANSPORTATION OF BIOFUEL OR ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS RESULTING
- 13 FROM BIOFUEL PRODUCTION.
- 14 (iii) USE OR REUSE OF ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS RESULTING FROM BIOFUEL
- 15 PRODUCTION.
- 16 (iv) STORAGE OF RAW MATERIALS, FUEL, OR ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS
- 17 USED IN, OR RESULTING FROM, BIOFUEL PRODUCTION.
- 18 (C) THE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION FACILITY INCLUDES SUFFICIENT
- 19 STORAGE FOR BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (i) RAW MATERIALS AND FUEL.
- 21 (ii) ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS RESULTING FROM BIOFUEL PRODUCTION OR
- 22 THE CAPACITY TO DISPOSE OF ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS THROUGH LAND
- 23 APPLICATION, LIVESTOCK CONSUMPTION, SALE, OR OTHER LEGAL USE.
- 24 (6) SUBSECTIONS (2) TO (5) DO NOT APPLY TO A BIOFUEL
- 25 PRODUCTION FACILITY IF THE ZONING ORDINANCE PROVIDES DIFFERENT
- 26 CRITERIA FOR SPECIAL LAND USE APPROVAL OF A BIOFUEL PRODUCTION
- 27 FACILITY LOCATED ON A FARM. AN AMENDMENT TO A ZONING ORDINANCE

- ADOPTED ONLY TO PROVIDE SUCH CRITERIA IS NOT SUBJECT TO A PROTEST 1
- 2 PETITION UNDER SECTION 403.
- 3 (7) A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT MAY AUTHORIZE A BIOFUEL
- 4 PRODUCTION FACILITY DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) AS A PERMITTED USE
- OF PROPERTY NOT SUBJECT TO A SPECIAL LAND USE APPROVAL. 5
- 6 (8) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT THE AUTHORITY OF A LOCAL UNIT
- OF GOVERNMENT TO PROHIBIT OR AUTHORIZE BIOFUEL PRODUCTION 7
- FACILITIES THAT ARE NOT LOCATED ON FARMS. 8
- 9 (9) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- (A) "BIOFUEL" MEANS ANY RENEWABLE FUEL PRODUCT, WHETHER SOLID, 10
- LIQUID, OR GAS, THAT IS DERIVED FROM RECENTLY LIVING ORGANISMS OR 11
- 12 THEIR METABOLIC BY-PRODUCTS AND MEETS APPLICABLE QUALITY STANDARDS,
- INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ETHANOL AND BIODIESEL. BIOFUEL DOES 13
- 14 NOT INCLUDE METHANE OR ANY OTHER FUEL PRODUCT FROM AN ANAEROBIC
- 15 DIGESTER.
- (B) "ETHANOL" MEANS A SUBSTANCE THAT MEETS THE ASTM 16
- 17 INTERNATIONAL STANDARD IN EFFECT ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS
- 18 SECTION AS THE D-4806 SPECIFICATION FOR DENATURED FUEL GRADE
- 19 ETHANOL FOR BLENDING WITH GASOLINE.
- 20 (C) "FARM" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE
- MICHIGAN RIGHT TO FARM ACT, 1981 PA 93, MCL 286.472. 21
- (D) "PROOF GALLON" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN 27 CFR 22
