## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 617

## A bill to amend 1967 PA 168, entitled

"An act to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain lands and to cede a certain water area in Alger county to the United States of America for use by the national park service; and to declare the effect thereof,"

by amending sections 1 and 4 (MCL 3.451 and 3.454) and by adding sections 4a, 4b, and 4c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board is authorized to MAY
- 2 convey by quit claim QUITCLAIM deed or deeds such THE title to
- 3 lands as is vested in the state of Michigan and under the
- 4 jurisdiction of the department of conservation NATURAL RESOURCES
- 5 and to MAY cede the off shore OFFSHORE water area, without any
- 6 monetary consideration, for and in ON behalf of the state of
- 7 Michigan, to the United States of America, as lie within the
- 8 boundaries of the shoreline zone of the Pictured Rocks national

- 1 lakeshore as depicted on the map identified as "proposed pictured
- 2 rocks-PICTURED ROCKS national lakeshore, United States department
- 3 of the interior, national park service, boundary map NL-PR-7001A,
- 4 July, 1966", to be used by the United States department of the
- 5 interior. The conservation NATURAL RESOURCES commission shall
- 6 approve the descriptions and total acreage of land to be conveyed
- 7 and water area to be ceded.
- 8 Sec. 4. The jurisdiction of such THE lands and water area
- 9 DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 is ceded to the United States of America
- 10 upon the express condition that the state of Michigan shall retain
- 11 concurrent jurisdiction, both civil and criminal, over persons on
- 12 such THE lands and water area, so that all civil and criminal
- 13 process issued by any court of competent jurisdiction or officer
- 14 having authority of law to issue such process and all orders made
- 15 by such THE court, or any judicial officer duly empowered
- 16 AUTHORIZED to make such THE orders necessary to be served upon any
- 17 person, may be executed upon such THE lands and water area in the
- 18 same manner as if jurisdiction had not been so ceded.
- 19 SEC. 4A. (1) IF THE UNITED STATES DESIRES TO ACQUIRE
- 20 CONCURRENT LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION OVER THE LANDS AND WATERS
- 21 WITHIN THE PICTURED ROCKS NATIONAL LAKESHORE THAT HAVE NOT
- 22 PREVIOUSLY BEEN CEDED UNDER SECTION 4, THE UNITED STATES SHALL
- 23 SUBMIT AN APPLICATION, IN WRITING, TO THE GOVERNOR. UPON RECEIPT OF
- 24 THE APPLICATION, THE GOVERNOR MAY CEDE TO THE UNITED STATES
- 25 JURISDICTION, NOT EXCEEDING THAT REQUESTED BY THE UNITED STATES,
- 26 OVER ANY OR ALL OF THE LANDS OR WATERS FOR WHICH JURISDICTION HAS
- 27 BEEN APPLIED, AND RESERVING TO THIS STATE CONCURRENT JURISDICTION

- 1 AS THE GOVERNOR CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE.
- 2 (2) AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (1) SHALL STATE
- 3 THE MEASURE OF JURISDICTION DESIRED AND SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN
- 4 ACCURATE DESCRIPTION OF THE LANDS OR WATERS, OR BOTH, OVER WHICH
- 5 JURISDICTION IS DESIRED AND INFORMATION AS TO WHICH OF THE LANDS
- 6 ARE OWNED BY THE UNITED STATES.
- 7 (3) THE CESSION OF JURISDICTION UNDER THIS SECTION BECOMES
- 8 EFFECTIVE WHEN IT IS ACCEPTED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 9 ACCEPTANCE BY THE UNITED STATES SHALL BE INDICATED IN WRITING UPON
- 10 THE INSTRUMENT OF CESSION BY AN AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL OF THE UNITED
- 11 STATES AND SHALL BE FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THIS
- 12 STATE.
- 13 SEC. 4B. (1) THIS STATE RESERVES JURISDICTION AS FOLLOWS OVER
- 14 LANDS AND WATERS WITHIN THE PICTURED ROCKS NATIONAL LAKESHORE, TO
- 15 WHICH LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION IS CEDED TO THE UNITED STATES UNDER
- 16 THIS ACT:
- 17 (A) THE STATE'S ENTIRE LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION WITH RESPECT
- 18 TO TAXATION BY THIS STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.
- 19 (B) THE STATE'S ENTIRE LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION WITH RESPECT
- 20 TO MARRIAGE, DIVORCE, ANNULMENT, ADOPTION, COMMITMENT OF THE
- 21 MENTALLY INCOMPETENT, AND DESCENT AND DISTRIBUTION OF PROPERTY.
- 22 (C) CONCURRENT OR SEPARATE POWER TO ENFORCE THE CRIMINAL LAW.
- 23 (D) THE POWER TO EXECUTE ANY PROCESS, CIVIL OR CRIMINAL,
- 24 ISSUED UNDER AUTHORITY OF THIS STATE.
- 25 (2) A PERSON RESIDING ON LANDS WITHIN THE PICTURED ROCKS
- 26 NATIONAL LAKESHORE, TO WHICH LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION IS CEDED TO
- 27 THE UNITED STATES UNDER THIS ACT, SHALL NOT BE DEPRIVED OF ANY

- CIVIL OR POLITICAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE, BY 1
- REASON OF THE CESSION OF JURISDICTION TO THE UNITED STATES. 2
- 3 SEC. 4C. IF THE UNITED STATES OFFERS TO THIS STATE A
- RELINQUISHMENT OF LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION OVER LANDS WITHIN THE 4
- PICTURED ROCKS NATIONAL LAKESHORE, THE GOVERNOR MAY ACCEPT ON 5
- 6 BEHALF OF THIS STATE THE LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION OFFERED TO BE
- 7 RELINQUISHED. THE GOVERNOR SHALL INDICATE HIS OR HER ACCEPTANCE OF
- RELINOUISHED LEGISLATIVE JURISDICTION BY A WRITING ADDRESSED TO THE 8
- 9 HEAD OF THE APPROPRIATE DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 10 THE ACCEPTANCE IS EFFECTIVE WHEN DEPOSITED IN A UNITED STATES POST
- 11 OFFICE OR MAILBOX.
