SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 768

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 411w.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 411W. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY SELL, PURCHASE,
- 2 INSTALL, TRANSFER, OR POSSESS IN THIS STATE ANY AUTOMATED SALES
- 3 SUPPRESSION DEVICE OR ZAPPER OR PHANTOM-WARE.
- 4 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 5 AND SHALL BE IMPRISONED FOR NOT LESS THAN 1 YEAR OR MORE THAN 5
- 6 YEARS AND, IN ADDITION, MAY BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100,000.00.
- 7 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS LIABLE FOR ALL
- 8 TAXES AND PENALTIES DUE THE STATE AS THE RESULT OF THE FRAUDULENT
- 9 USE OF AN AUTOMATED SALES SUPPRESSION DEVICE OR PHANTOM-WARE AND
- 10 SHALL DISGORGE ALL PROFITS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SALE OR USE OF AN

- 1 AUTOMATED SALES SUPPRESSION DEVICE OR PHANTOM-WARE.
- 2 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 3 (A) "AUTOMATED SALES SUPPRESSION DEVICE" OR "ZAPPER" MEANS A
- 4 SOFTWARE PROGRAM CARRIED ON A MEMORY STICK OR REMOVABLE COMPACT
- 5 DISC, ACCESSED THROUGH AN INTERNET LINK, OR ACCESSED THROUGH ANY
- 6 OTHER MEANS, THAT FALSIFIES THE ELECTRONIC RECORDS OF ELECTRONIC
- 7 CASH REGISTERS AND OTHER POINT-OF-SALE SYSTEMS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 8 LIMITED TO, TRANSACTION DATA AND TRANSACTION REPORTS.
- 9 (B) "ELECTRONIC CASH REGISTER" MEANS A DEVICE THAT KEEPS A
- 10 REGISTER OR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS THROUGH THE MEANS OF AN ELECTRONIC
- 11 DEVICE OR COMPUTER SYSTEM DESIGNED TO RECORD TRANSACTION DATA FOR
- 12 THE PURPOSE OF COMPUTING, COMPILING, OR PROCESSING RETAIL SALES
- 13 TRANSACTION DATA IN WHATEVER MANNER.
- 14 (C) "PHANTOM-WARE" MEANS A HIDDEN, PREINSTALLED, OR INSTALLED
- 15 AT A LATER TIME PROGRAMMING OPTION EMBEDDED IN THE OPERATING SYSTEM
- 16 OF AN ELECTRONIC CASH REGISTER OR HARDWIRED INTO THE ELECTRONIC
- 17 CASH REGISTER THAT CAN BE USED TO CREATE A VIRTUAL SECOND TILL OR
- 18 MAY ELIMINATE OR MANIPULATE TRANSACTION RECORDS THAT MAY OR MAY NOT
- 19 BE PRESERVED IN DIGITAL FORMATS TO REPRESENT THE TRUE OR
- 20 MANIPULATED RECORD OF TRANSACTIONS IN THE ELECTRONIC CASH REGISTER.
- 21 (D) "TRANSACTION DATA" INCLUDES INFORMATION REGARDING ITEMS
- 22 PURCHASED BY A CUSTOMER, THE PRICE FOR EACH ITEM, A TAXABILITY
- 23 DETERMINATION FOR EACH ITEM, A SEGREGATED TAX AMOUNT FOR EACH OF
- 24 THE TAXED ITEMS, THE AMOUNT OF CASH OR CREDIT TENDERED, THE NET
- 25 AMOUNT RETURNED TO THE CUSTOMER IN CHANGE, THE DATE AND TIME OF THE
- 26 PURCHASE, THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF THE
- 27 VENDOR, AND THE RECEIPT OR INVOICE NUMBER OF THE TRANSACTION.

- (E) "TRANSACTION REPORT" MEANS A REPORT THAT INCLUDES, BUT 1
- 2 NEED NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE SALES, TAXES COLLECTED, MEDIA TOTALS,
- 3 AND DISCOUNT VOIDS AT AN ELECTRONIC CASH REGISTER THAT IS PRINTED
- ON CASH REGISTER TAPE AT THE END OF A DAY OR SHIFT, OR A REPORT
- DOCUMENTING EVERY ACTION AT AN ELECTRONIC CASH REGISTER THAT IS 5
- STORED ELECTRONICALLY. 6
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- after the date it is enacted into law.
