SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 263

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 17902 (MCL 333.17902), as added by 2006 PA 54.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 17902. (1) Beginning on the effective date of the rules
- 2 promulgated under section 17904 FEBRUARY 4, 2010, an individual
- 3 shall not engage in the practice of athletic training unless
- 4 licensed under this part or otherwise authorized to engage in the
- 5 practice of athletic training under subsection (2) THIS SECTION. An
- 6 individual licensed under this part shall not provide, offer to
- 7 provide, or represent that he or she is qualified to provide any
- 8 services that he or she is not qualified to perform by his or her
- 9 education, training, or experience or that he or she is otherwise
- 10 prohibited by law from performing.

- 1 (2) Subsection (1) does not prohibit an individual licensed
- 2 under any other part or any other act from performing activities
- 3 that are considered the practice of athletic training so long as
- 4 those activities are within the individual's scope of practice and
- 5 the individual does not use the titles protected under subsection
- **6** (3).
- 7 (3) Beginning EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION,
- 8 BEGINNING on the effective date of the rules promulgated under
- 9 section 17904 FEBRUARY 4, 2010, an individual shall not use the
- 10 titles "athletic trainer", "licensed athletic trainer", "certified
- 11 athletic trainer", "athletic trainer certified", "a.t.", "a.t.l.",
- 12 "c.a.t.", "a.t.c.", or similar words that indicate that the person
- 13 is an athletic trainer unless the individual is licensed under this
- 14 article as an athletic trainer.
- 15 (4) THIS PART DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO IS TEMPORARILY
- 16 PRESENT IN THIS STATE FOR AN EVENT THAT USES THE SERVICES OF
- 17 ATHLETIC TRAINERS AND WHO IS A BOARD OF CERTIFICATION CERTIFIED
- 18 ATHLETIC TRAINER OR IS LICENSED AS AN ATHLETIC TRAINER IN ANOTHER
- 19 STATE.
