## SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 402

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 5139.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 5139. (1) A PHYSICIAN OR AN OPTOMETRIST HAS NO
- 2 AFFIRMATIVE OBLIGATION TO BUT MAY VOLUNTARILY REPORT TO THE
- 3 SECRETARY OF STATE OR WARN THIRD PARTIES REGARDING A PATIENT'S
- 4 MENTAL AND PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A
- 5 MANNER AS NOT TO JEOPARDIZE THE SAFETY OF PERSONS AND PROPERTY DUE
- 6 TO AN EPISODE. A PHYSICIAN OR AN OPTOMETRIST WHO CHOOSES NOT TO
- 7 MAKE A REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OR WARN THIRD PARTIES AS
- 8 PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS IMMUNE FROM ANY CRIMINAL OR
- 9 CIVIL LIABILITY TO THE PATIENT OR THIRD PARTY THAT MAY HAVE BEEN
- 10 INJURED BY THE PATIENT'S ACTIONS.
- 11 (2) A PHYSICIAN OR AN OPTOMETRIST MAY MAKE A REPORT UNDER THIS

- 1 SECTION AND SUBMIT THAT REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE
- 2 PURPOSE OF INITIATING OR CONTRIBUTING TO AN EXAMINATION OF AN
- 3 APPLICANT'S PHYSICAL AND MENTAL QUALIFICATIONS TO OPERATE A MOTOR
- 4 VEHICLE IN A MANNER AS NOT TO JEOPARDIZE THE SAFETY OF PERSONS AND
- 5 PROPERTY PURSUANT TO SECTION 309 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949
- 6 PA 300, MCL 257.309. IN MAKING THAT REPORT, THE PHYSICIAN OR
- 7 OPTOMETRIST SHALL RECOMMEND A PERIOD OF SUSPENSION AS DETERMINED
- 8 APPROPRIATE BY THE PHYSICIAN OR OPTOMETRIST AS FOLLOWS:
- 9 (A) IN THE CASE OF A PATIENT HOLDING AN OPERATOR'S LICENSE,
- 10 THAT THE SUSPENSION BE FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS OR LONGER.
- 11 (B) IN THE CASE OF A PATIENT HOLDING A COMMERCIAL LICENSE,
- 12 THAT THE SUSPENSION BE FOR AT LEAST 12 MONTHS OR LONGER.
- 13 (3) A PHYSICIAN OR AN OPTOMETRIST MAKING A REPORT UNDER
- 14 SUBSECTION (2), ACTING IN GOOD FAITH AND EXERCISING DUE CARE AS
- 15 EVIDENCED BY DOCUMENTING HIS OR HER FILE OR MEDICAL RECORD
- 16 REGARDING AN EPISODE, IS IMMUNE FROM ANY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL
- 17 LIABILITY RESULTING FROM THE REPORT TO THE PATIENT OR A THIRD PARTY
- 18 THAT MAY HAVE BEEN INJURED BY THE PATIENT'S ACTIONS.
- 19 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 20 (A) "EPISODE" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 21 (i) AN EXPERIENCE DERIVED FROM A CONDITION THAT CAUSES OR
- 22 CONTRIBUTES TO LOSS OF CONSCIOUSNESS, BLACKOUT, SEIZURE, A FAINTING
- 23 SPELL, SYNCOPE, OR ANY OTHER IMPAIRMENT OF THE LEVEL OF
- 24 CONSCIOUSNESS.
- 25 (ii) AN EXPERIENCE DERIVED FROM A CONDITION THAT CAUSES AN
- 26 IMPAIRMENT OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVING JUDGMENT.
- 27 (iii) AN EXPERIENCE DERIVED FROM AN IMPAIRMENT OF AN

- 1 INDIVIDUAL'S VISION.
- 2 (B) "OPTOMETRIST" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED UNDER PART 174.
- 3 (C) "PHYSICIAN" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED UNDER PART 170 OR
- 4 175.
- 5 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 6 unless Senate Bill No. 403 of the 96th Legislature is enacted into
- 7 law.
