SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 787

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 21313 (MCL 333.21313), as amended by 2010 PA 381.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 21313. (1) The owner, operator, and governing body of a
- 2 home for the aged are responsible for all phases of the operation
- 3 of the home and shall assure that the home maintains an organized
- 4 program to provide room and board, protection, supervision,
- 5 assistance, and supervised personal care for its residents.
- 6 (2) The owner, operator, and governing body shall assure the
- 7 availability of emergency medical care required by a resident.

- 1 (3) The owner, operator, or member of the governing body of a
- 2 home for the aged and the authorized representative shall be of
- 3 good moral character.
- 4 (4) The department OF HUMAN SERVICES shall not issue a license
- 5 to or renew the license of an owner, operator, or member of the
- 6 governing body, who has regular direct access to residents or who
- 7 has on-site facility operational responsibilities, or an applicant,
- 8 if an individual or the authorized representative, if any of those
- 9 individuals have been convicted of 1 or more of the following:
- 10 (a) A felony under this act or under chapter XXA of the
- 11 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.145m to 750.145r.
- 12 (b) A misdemeanor under this act or under chapter XXA of the
- 13 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.145m to 750.145r, within
- 14 the 10 years immediately preceding the application.
- 15 (c) A misdemeanor involving abuse, neglect, assault, battery,
- 16 or criminal sexual conduct or involving fraud or theft against a
- 17 vulnerable adult as that term is defined in section 145m of the
- 18 Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.145m, or a state or
- 19 federal crime that is substantially similar to a misdemeanor
- 20 described in this subdivision within the 10 years immediately
- 21 preceding the application.
- 22 (5) The applicant for a license for a home for the aged, if an
- 23 individual, shall give written consent at the time of license
- 24 application for the department of state police to conduct a
- 25 criminal history check and criminal records check. The AND THE
- 26 authorized representative shall give written consent at the time of
- 27 appointment, for the department of state police to conduct a

- 3 (A) A CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK.
- 4 (B) A CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK THROUGH THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF

- 6 (6) An—UNLESS ALREADY SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (5), AN
- 7 owner, operator, or member of the governing body who has regular
- 8 direct access to residents or who has on-site facility operational
- 9 responsibilities for a home for the aged shall give written consent
- 10 at the time of license application for the department of state
- 11 police to conduct a criminal history check and criminal records
- 12 check.BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (A) A CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK.
- 14 (B) A CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK THROUGH THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF
- 15 INVESTIGATION.
- 16 (7) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES SHALL REQUIRE THE
- 17 APPLICANT, AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, OWNER, OPERATOR, OR MEMBER OF
- 18 THE GOVERNING BODY WHO HAS REGULAR DIRECT ACCESS TO RESIDENTS OR
- 19 WHO HAS ON-SITE FACILITY OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES TO SUBMIT HIS
- 20 OR HER FINGERPRINTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE FOR THE
- 21 CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK AND CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK DESCRIBED IN
- 22 SUBSECTIONS (5) AND (6).
- 23 (8) (7) Not later than 1 year after the effective date of the
- 24 2010 2012 amendatory act that added AMENDED this subsection, all
- 25 owners, operators, and members of the governing body of homes for
- 26 the aged who have regular direct access to residents or who have
- 27 on-site facility operational responsibilities and all authorized

- 1 representatives shall comply with the requirements of this section.
- 2 (9) (8) The department of human services shall request a
- 3 criminal history check and criminal records check in the manner
- 4 prescribed by the department of state police. The department of
- 5 state police shall conduct the criminal history check and provide a
- 6 report of the results to the licensing or regulatory bureau of the
- 7 department of human services. The report shall contain any criminal
- 8 history information on the person maintained by the department of
- 9 state police and the results of the criminal records check from the
- 10 federal bureau of investigation. The department of state police may
- 11 charge the person on whom the criminal history check and criminal
- 12 records check are performed under this section a fee for the checks
- 13 required under this section that does not exceed the actual cost
- 14 and reasonable cost of conducting the checks.
- 15 (10) BEGINNING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE 2012 AMENDATORY ACT
- 16 THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, IF AN APPLICANT, AUTHORIZED
- 17 REPRESENTATIVE, OWNER, OPERATOR, OR MEMBER OF THE GOVERNING BODY
- 18 WHO HAS REGULAR DIRECT ACCESS TO RESIDENTS OR WHO HAS ON-SITE
- 19 FACILITY OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES APPLIES FOR A LICENSE OR TO
- 20 RENEW A LICENSE TO OPERATE A HOME FOR THE AGED AND PREVIOUSLY
- 21 UNDERWENT A CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK AND CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK
- 22 REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (5) OR (6) OR UNDER SECTION 134A OF THE
- 23 MENTAL HEALTH CODE, 1974 PA 258, MCL 330.1134A, AND HAS REMAINED
- 24 CONTINUOUSLY LICENSED OR CONTINUOUSLY EMPLOYED UNDER SECTION 20173A
- 25 OR UNDER SECTION 34B OF THE ADULT FOSTER CARE FACILITY LICENSING
- 26 ACT, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.734B, AFTER THE CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK
- 27 AND CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK HAVE BEEN PERFORMED, THE APPLICANT,

- 1 AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, OWNER, OPERATOR, OR MEMBER OF THE
- 2 GOVERNING BODY WHO HAS REGULAR DIRECT ACCESS TO RESIDENTS OR WHO
- 3 HAS ON-SITE FACILITY OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES IS NOT REQUIRED
- 4 TO SUBMIT TO ANOTHER CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK OR CRIMINAL RECORDS
- 5 CHECK UPON RENEWAL OF THE LICENSE OBTAINED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 6 (11) (9) The department of state police shall store and
- 7 maintain all fingerprints submitted under this act in an automated
- 8 fingerprint identification system database that provides for an
- 9 automatic notification at the time a subsequent criminal arrest
- 10 fingerprint card submitted into the system matches a set of
- 11 fingerprints previously submitted in accordance with this act. At
- 12 the time of that notification, the department of state police shall
- 13 immediately notify the department of human services. The department
- 14 of human services shall take the appropriate action upon
- 15 notification by the department of state police under this
- 16 subsection.
- 17 (12) (10) An applicant, owner, operator, member of a governing
- 18 body, or authorized representative of a home for the aged shall not
- 19 be present in a home for the aged if he or she has been convicted
- 20 of either of the following:
- 21 (a) Vulnerable adult abuse, neglect, or financial
- 22 exploitation.
- 23 (b) A listed offense as defined in section 2 of the sex
- 24 offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.722.
