April 25, 2012, Introduced by Senator KOWALL and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1987 PA 96, entitled
"The mobile home commission act,"
by amending sections 2 and 30a (MCL 125.2302 and 125.2330a),
section 30a as amended by 2006 PA 328.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Campground" means a campground as defined in section
 - 12501 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of
 - 1978, being section 333.12501 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.1978 PA
- 5 368, MCL 333.12501.

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- (b) "Code" means all or a part of the mobile home code
- promulgated pursuant to section 5.
 - (c) "Commission" means the mobile home code commission.

- 1 (d) "Department" means the department of commerce.LICENSING
- 2 AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS, EXCEPT THAT DEPARTMENT MEANS THE DEPARTMENT
- 3 OF STATE IN ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:
- 4 (i) AS USED IN SECTION 5(1) WITH RESPECT TO RULES PROMULGATED
- 5 UNDER SECTION 5(1)(H).
- 6 (ii) AS USED IN SECTION 9(5) WITH RESPECT TO RULES ADJUSTING
- 7 FEES UNDER SECTION 30A OR 30C.
- 8 (iii) AS USED IN SECTIONS 30 TO 30I.
- 9 (e) "Installer and repairer" means a person, including a
- 10 mobile home dealer, who for compensation installs or repairs mobile
- 11 homes.
- 12 (f) "Local government" means a county or municipality.
- 13 (g) "Mobile home" means a structure, transportable in 1 or
- 14 more sections, which is built on a chassis and designed to be used
- 15 as a dwelling with or without permanent foundation, when connected
- 16 to the required utilities, and includes the plumbing, heating, air-
- 17 conditioning, and electrical systems contained in the structure.
- (h) "Mobile home dealer" means a person other than a
- 19 manufacturer engaged in the business of buying mobile homes for
- 20 resale, exchange, lease, or rent or offering mobile homes for sale,
- 21 lease, rent, or exchange to customers.
- (i) "Mobile home park" means a parcel or tract of land under
- 23 the control of a person upon which 3 or more mobile homes are
- 24 located on a continual, nonrecreational basis and which is offered
- 25 to the public for that purpose regardless of whether a charge is
- 26 made therefor, together with any building, structure, enclosure,
- 27 street, equipment, or facility used or intended for use incident to

- 1 the occupancy of a mobile home.
- 2 (j) "Municipality" means a city, village, or township.
- 3 (k) "Person" means an individual, partnership, association,
- 4 trust, or corporation, or any other legal entity or combination of
- 5 legal entities.
- 6 (1) "Recreational vehicle" means a vehicle primarily designed
- 7 and used as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or
- 8 travel purposes, including a vehicle having its own motor power or
- 9 a vehicle mounted on or drawn by another vehicle.
- 10 (m) "Seasonal mobile home park" means a parcel or tract of
- 11 land under the control of a person upon which 3 or more mobile
- 12 homes are located on a continual or temporary basis but occupied on
- 13 a temporary basis only, and which is offered to the public for that
- 14 purpose regardless of whether a charge is made therefor, together
- 15 with any building, enclosure, street, equipment, or facility used
- 16 or intended for use incident to the occupancy of a mobile home.
- 17 Seasonal mobile home park does not include a campground licensed
- 18 pursuant to sections 12501 to 12516 of the public health code, Act
- 19 No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.12501 to
- 20 333.12516 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.1978 PA 368, MCL 333.12501
- 21 TO 333.12516.
- 22 (n) "Security interest", "security agreement", "secured
- 23 party", and "termination statement" have the same meanings as in
- 24 the uniform commercial code, Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of
- 25 1962, being sections 440.1101 to 440.11102 of the Michigan Compiled
- 26 Laws. "SECURED PARTY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 9102 OF
- 27 THE UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE, 1962 PA 174, MCL 440.9102.

- 1 (O) "SECURITY INTEREST" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
- 2 1201 OF THE UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE, 1962 PA 174, MCL 440.1201.
- 3 (P) "TERMINATION STATEMENT" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 4 SECTION 9102 OF THE UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE, 1962 PA 174, MCL
- 5 440.9102.
- 6 Sec. 30a. (1) An owner of a mobile home which is subject to
- 7 the certificate of title provisions of this act shall make
- 8 application APPLY to the department for the issuance of a
- 9 certificate of title for the mobile home upon the appropriate form
- 10 furnished by the department, accompanied by a fee of \$90.00 or any
- 11 lesser amount established pursuant to section 9(5). The application
- 12 shall bear the signature of the owner written in ink, shall be
- 13 acknowledged by the owner before a person authorized to take
- 14 acknowledgments, and shall contain:
- 15 (a) The name and address of the owner.
- 16 (b) A description of the mobile home, including the name of
- 17 the manufacturer, the year and model, and the manufacturer's serial
- 18 number or, in the absence of a serial number, a number assigned by
- 19 the department. A number assigned by the department shall be
- 20 permanently placed on the mobile home in the manner and place
- 21 designated by the department.
- 22 (c) A statement of the names and addresses of the holders of
- 23 any security interests in the mobile home, in the order of their
- 24 priority.
- 25 (d) Further information as may reasonably be required by the
- 26 department to enable it to determine whether the owner of the
- 27 mobile home APPLICANT is entitled to a certificate of title for the

- 1 mobile home.
- 2 (2) If the department is not satisfied as to the ownership of
- 3 the mobile home, before issuing a certificate of title for it, the
- 4 department may require the applicant to file a properly executed
- 5 surety bond in a form prescribed by the department, executed by the
- 6 applicant and a company authorized to conduct a surety business in
- 7 this state. The bond shall be in an amount equal to twice the value
- 8 of the mobile home as determined by the department and shall be
- 9 conditioned to indemnify or reimburse the department, any prior
- 10 owner, any holder of a security interest in the mobile home, and
- 11 any subsequent purchaser of the mobile home, and their successors
- 12 in interest, against any expense, loss, or damage, including
- 13 reasonable attorney's fees, by reason of the issuance of a
- 14 certificate of title to the mobile home or on account of any defect
- 15 in the right, title, or interest of the applicant in and to the
- 16 mobile home. Each interested person has a right of action to
- 17 recover on the bond for a breach of its conditions, but the
- 18 aggregate liability of the surety to all persons shall not exceed
- 19 the amount of the bond. The bond shall be returned at the end of 5
- 20 years, or before 5 years if the currently valid certificate of
- 21 title is surrendered to the department, unless the department has
- 22 received notification of the pendency of an action to recover on
- 23 the bond.
- 24 (3) The department shall examine and determine the
- 25 genuineness, regularity, and legality of an application for a
- 26 certificate of title for a mobile home and of any other application
- 27 lawfully made to the department, and may in all cases make

- 1 investigation or require additional information as may be
- 2 considered necessary, and shall reject any application if not
- 3 satisfied of the ITS genuineness, regularity, or legality of it or
- 4 OF the truth of any statement contained in it, or for any other
- 5 reason , when authorized by law.
- 6 (4) The fee for obtaining a duplicate, replacement, or
- 7 corrected title, for placing or terminating a lien on the title, or
- 8 for placing a name on the title is \$15.00 or any other UNLESS A
- 9 lesser amount **IS** established pursuant to section 9(5).
- 10 (5) AN APPLICATION FOR A DUPLICATE TITLE SHALL BE ON A FORM
- 11 PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE A
- 12 CERTIFICATION THAT THE APPLICANT OWNS THE MOBILE HOME AND THAT ALL
- 13 INFORMATION ON THE APPLICATION IS COMPLETE TO THE BEST OF THE
- 14 APPLICANT'S KNOWLEDGE. THE APPLICANT SHALL SIGN THE APPLICATION OR,
- 15 IF THE APPLICATION IS FILED ELECTRONICALLY, PROVIDE INFORMATION
- 16 REQUESTED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO VERIFY THE APPLICANT'S IDENTITY.
