HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1122

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 9155.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 9155. (1) BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF 90 DAYS AFTER THE
- 2 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP,
- 3 ADOPT, OR APPROVE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS ON THE NATURE AND RISK OF
- 4 CONCUSSIONS.
- 5 (2) BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE
- 6 OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP, ADOPT, OR APPROVE A
- 7 CONCUSSION AWARENESS TRAINING PROGRAM IN AN ELECTRONIC FORMAT THAT
- 8 INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 (A) THE NATURE AND RISK OF CONCUSSIONS.
- 2 (B) THE CRITERIA FOR THE REMOVAL OF AN ATHLETE FROM PHYSICAL
- 3 PARTICIPATION IN AN ATHLETIC ACTIVITY DUE TO A SUSPECTED CONCUSSION
- 4 AND HIS OR HER RETURN TO THAT ATHLETIC ACTIVITY.
- 5 (C) THE RISKS TO AN ATHLETE OF NOT REPORTING A SUSPECTED
- 6 CONCUSSION AND CONTINUING TO PHYSICALLY PARTICIPATE IN THE ATHLETIC
- 7 ACTIVITY.
- 8 (3) AS SOON AS THEY ARE AVAILABLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE
- 9 THE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS AND TRAINING PROGRAM REQUIRED UNDER THIS
- 10 SECTION AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON THE DEPARTMENT'S INTERNET
- 11 WEBSITE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE THE TRAINING PROGRAM AVAILABLE
- 12 TO ALL INDIVIDUALS REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM UNDER
- 13 SECTION 9156 AND TO ANY INTERESTED INDIVIDUAL INCLUDING SCHOOL
- 14 PERSONNEL, COACHES, PARENTS, STUDENTS, AND ATHLETES.
- 15 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION AND SECTION 9156:
- 16 (A) "APPROPRIATE HEALTH PROFESSIONAL" MEANS A HEALTH
- 17 PROFESSIONAL WHO IS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN A
- 18 HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER ARTICLE 15 AND WHOSE SCOPE OF PRACTICE
- 19 WITHIN THAT HEALTH PROFESSION INCLUDES THE RECOGNITION, TREATMENT,
- 20 AND MANAGEMENT OF CONCUSSIONS.
- 21 (B) "ATHLETIC ACTIVITY" MEANS A PROGRAM OR EVENT, INCLUDING
- 22 PRACTICE AND COMPETITION, DURING WHICH YOUTH ATHLETES PARTICIPATE
- 23 OR PRACTICE TO PARTICIPATE IN AN ORGANIZED ATHLETIC GAME OR
- 24 COMPETITION AGAINST ANOTHER TEAM, CLUB, ENTITY, OR INDIVIDUAL.
- 25 ATHLETIC ACTIVITY INCLUDES PARTICIPATION IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION
- 26 CLASSES THAT ARE PART OF A SCHOOL CURRICULUM.
- 27 (C) "CONCUSSION" MEANS A TYPE OF TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY AS

- 1 RECOGNIZED BY THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION. A
- 2 CONCUSSION MAY CAUSE A CHANGE IN A PERSON'S MENTAL STATUS AT THE
- 3 TIME OF THE INJURY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, FEELING DAZED,
- 4 DISORIENTED, OR CONFUSED, AND MAY OR MAY NOT INVOLVE A LOSS OF
- 5 CONSCIOUSNESS. A CONCUSSION MAY BE CAUSED BY ANY TYPE OF ACCIDENT
- 6 OR INJURY INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (i) A FALL.
- 8 (ii) A BLOW, BUMP, OR JOLT TO THE HEAD OR BODY.
- 9 (iii) THE SHAKING OR SPINNING OF THE HEAD OR BODY.
- 10 (iv) THE ACCELERATION AND DECELERATION OF THE HEAD.
- 11 (D) "ORGANIZING ENTITY" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 12 (i) A SCHOOL.
- 13 (ii) A STATE OR LOCAL PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT OR
- 14 COMMISSION OR OTHER STATE OR LOCAL ENTITY.
- 15 (iii) A NONPROFIT OR FOR-PROFIT ENTITY.
- 16 (iv) A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE ENTITY.
- 17 (E) "SCHOOL" MEANS A NONPUBLIC SCHOOL, PUBLIC SCHOOL, OR
- 18 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION 5 OF
- 19 THE REVISED SCHOOL CODE, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.
- 20 (F) "YOUTH ATHLETE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PARTICIPATES IN AN
- 21 ATHLETIC ACTIVITY AND WHO IS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE.
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 23 unless House Bill No. 5697 of the 96th Legislature is enacted into
- 24 law.
