A bill to amend 1984 PA 22, entitled "Michigan civilian conservation corps act," by amending sections 11 and 12a (MCL 409.311 and 409.312a), section 12a as amended by 2007 PA 147.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 11. (1) The corps shall assist corpsmembers in obtaining employment after their participation in a corps program.

(2) The corps shall ensure that conservation programs established under this act do not SHALL NOT BE DESIGNED SO AS TO displace currently employed workers, or impair existing contracts for service provided by other workers, and that no corpsmember is SHALL BE used in any manner in connection with a work or labor
