THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. Residents of this state may purchase rifles and shotguns in any state contiguous thereto—if they conform to the federal gun control act of 1968, PUBLIC LAW 90-618, and the regulations issued thereunder, UNDER THAT ACT, as administered by the secretary of the treasury, and WITH the laws of the state where IN WHICH the purchase is made.

Sec. 2. Residents of a contiguous ANOTHER state may purchase rifles and shotguns in this state if they conform to the federal gun control act of 1968, PUBLIC LAW 70-618, and the regulations issued thereunder UNDER THAT ACT, as administered by the secretary
