THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "legislative health benefits act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Health coverage" means hospital, medical-surgical,
- 5 dental, optical, and hearing insurance benefits.
 - (b) "Legislator" means an individual duly elected and serving in the house of representatives or senate of this state.
 - Sec. 3. Any health coverage that this state provides to a legislator during the legislator's term of office shall be on the same terms as health coverage offered to nonexclusively represented employees of this state.
