A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 931a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 931A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT PROVIDE FALSE INFORMATION TO
- 2 A REGISTERED ELECTOR THAT THE PERSON KNOWS TO BE FALSE AND THAT IS
- 3 INTENDED TO IMPEDE THE REGISTERED ELECTOR IN EXERCISING HIS OR HER
- 4 RIGHT TO VOTE AT AN ELECTION. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "FALSE
- 5 INFORMATION" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) THE DATE OR TIME OF AN ELECTION.
 - (B) THE LOCATION OF A VOTING PRECINCT OR POLLING PLACE.
 - (C) THE REGISTRATION STATUS OF A REGISTERED ELECTOR.
 - (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 10 MISDEMEANOR.
