HOUSE BILL No. 5437

February 23, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Zorn and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 239, entitled

"McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act,"

by amending section 32 (MCL 432.32), as amended by 1996 PA 13.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 32. (1) Before payment of a prize of \$1,000.00 or more,
- 2 the bureau shall determine whether the BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) WHETHER department of treasury records show that a—THE
- 4 lottery winner has a current liability to this state or a support
- 5 arrearage.
 - (B) WHETHER UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AGENCY RECORDS SHOW THAT
 THE LOTTERY WINNER HAS ANY CURRENT LIABILITY FOR RESTITUTION OF
 UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS, PENALTY, OR INTEREST UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE
 MICHIGAN EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ACT, 1936 (EX SESS) PA 1, MCL 421.15.
 - (2) The department of treasury shall provide the bureau with a

- 1 list or computer access to a compilation of persons known to the
- 2 department to have a current liability to this state, including
- 3 delinquent accounts of amounts MONEY due and owing to a court that
- 4 have been assigned to the THIS state for collection, or a support
- 5 arrearage. The information shall be updated not less than once a

- 7 (3) If a liability to this state, or A support arrearage, OR
- 8 AN UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION DEBT is identified UNDER SUBSECTION
- 9 (1), the bureau shall ascertain the amount owed from the department
- 10 of treasury and first OR THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AGENCY, AS
- 11 APPLICABLE.
- 12 (4) AFTER ASCERTAINING THE AMOUNT OWED BY THE LOTTERY WINNER
- 13 UNDER SUBSECTION (3), THE BUREAU SHALL apply the amount of the
- 14 prize AS FOLLOWS:
- 15 (A) FIRST to the ANY liability to the THIS state other than
- 16 the amount of any AN assigned delinquent account of amounts MONEY
- 17 due and owing to a court , next OR AN UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION
- 18 DEBT.
- 19 (B) NEXT to the ANY support arrearage. 7 and next
- 20 (C) NEXT TO ANY UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION DEBT.
- 21 (D) NEXT to the ANY assigned delinquent accounts of amounts
- 22 MONEY due and owing to a court. , and the excess,
- 23 (E) THE BALANCE, if any, shall be paid to the lottery winner.
- 24 (5) (2) A EXCEPT FOR A PAYMENT APPLIED TO A LIABILITY UNDER
- 25 SUBSECTION (4)(C), A lottery winner shall receive BE GIVEN notice
- 26 and an opportunity for a hearing before the department of treasury
- 27 or its designee with respect to the liability to which the prize is

- 12 the same manner as is prescribed for a payment pursuant to an order
- 13 of income withholding under section 9 of the support and parenting

- 15 295, being section MCL 552.609. of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- 16 (7) (4)—In regard to the—information provided by the
- 17 department of treasury to the bureau under this section, the bureau
- 18 is subject to the confidentiality restrictions and penalties
- 19 provided in section 28(1)(f) and (2) of Act No. 122 of the Public
- 20 Acts of 1941 PA 122, being section MCL 205.28. of the Michigan
- 21 Compiled Laws. IN REGARD TO INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE
- 22 UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AGENCY TO THE BUREAU UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE
- 23 MICHIGAN EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ACT, 1936 (EX SESS) PA 1, MCL 421.15,
- 24 THE BUREAU IS SUBJECT TO THE CONFIDENTIALITY RESTRICTIONS AND
- 25 PENALTIES PROVIDED IN SECTIONS 11 AND 54 OF THE MICHIGAN EMPLOYMENT
- 26 SECURITY ACT, 1936 (EX SESS) PA 1, MCL 421.11 AND 421.54.
- 27 (8) (5) Until October 1, 1995 each office of the friend of the
