## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 30. (1) The expiration, before or after the effective
- 2 date of this act, of any period of time specified by contract,
- 3 statute, or court order, during which a claim for money or property
- 4 can be made or during which an action or proceeding may be
- 5 commenced or enforced to obtain payment of a claim for money or to
- 6 recover property, does not prevent the money or property from being
- 7 presumed abandoned or affect any duty to file a report or to pay or
  - deliver abandoned property to the administrator as required by this
  - act. This subsection does not apply to gift cards or gift
- 10 certificates.

- 1 (2) An action or proceeding shall not be commenced by the
- 2 administrator with respect to any duty of a holder under this act
- 3 more than 10-5 years after the duty arose.
- 4 Sec. 32. (1) A holder required to file a report under section
- 5 18, as to any property for which it has obtained the last known
- 6 address of the owner, shall maintain a record of the name and last
- 7 known address of the owner for 10-5 years after the property
- 8 becomes reportable, except to the extent that a shorter time is
- 9 provided in subsection (2) or by rule of the administrator.
