- 1 Sec. 3d. (1) The department of labor_LICENSING AND REGULATORY
- 2 AFFAIRS shall issue an electrical journeyman's license to a person
- 3 not less than ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT LEAST 20 years of age AND
- 4 who does all of the following:
 - (a) Files a completed application form provided by the department of labor.LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS.
 - (b) Pays the examination fee prescribed in REQUIRED UNDER section 3 and passes an examination provided for by the board and the department of labor.LICENSING AND REGULATORY AFFAIRS.
 - (c) Pays the license fee prescribed in REQUIRED UNDER section
