HOUSE BILL No. 5608

May 9, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Womack and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 239, entitled "McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery act," by amending sections 12, 33, and 41 (MCL 432.12, 432.33, and 432.41), section 12 as amended by 2011 PA 279, section 33 as amended by 1996 PA 167, and section 41 as amended by 2009 PA 25, and by adding sections 10 and 45.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 10. (1) THE COMMISSIONER MAY ESTABLISH A SEPARATE CITY LOTTERY GAME.
- 3 (2) THE COMMISSIONER MAY PROMULGATE RULES, INCLUDING RULES ON 4 THE TOPICS LISTED IN SECTION 11, TO IMPLEMENT A SEPARATE LOTTERY
- GAME ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION. THE RULES MAY PROVIDE THAT
 - TICKETS OR SHARES IN THE SEPARATE LOTTERY GAME BE SOLD UNDER THE

- 1 NAME OF 1 OR MORE CITIES RECEIVING MONEY FROM THE CITY LOTTERY FUND
- 2 CREATED IN SECTION 45. THE RULES SHALL BE PROMULGATED UNDER THE
- 3 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO
- 4 24.328.
- 5 (3) TICKETS OR SHARES OF A SEPARATE LOTTERY GAME ESTABLISHED
- 6 UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE SOLD BY ALL LOTTERY AGENTS THAT SELL
- 7 TICKETS FOR THE STATE LOTTERY.
- 8 (4) MONEY FROM THE SALE OF TICKETS OR SHARES OF A SEPARATE
- 9 LOTTERY GAME ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN
- 10 THE CITY LOTTERY FUND CREATED IN SECTION 45.
- 11 (5) EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE, THE PROVISIONS
- 12 OF THIS ACT THAT ARE GENERALLY APPLICABLE TO THE CONDUCT OF THE
- 13 STATE LOTTERY APPLY TO THE CONDUCT OF A SEPARATE LOTTERY GAME
- 14 ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 15 Sec. 12. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2),
- 16 as—AS nearly as is practicable, not less than 45% of the total
- 17 annual revenue accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares
- 18 shall be apportioned for payment of prizes to the holders of
- 19 winning tickets or shares.
- 20 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the prize money from the
- 21 sale of tickets or shares of any joint enterprise is that
- 22 percentage of the total annual revenue accrued from that game as
- 23 prescribed by the joint enterprise participation agreement executed
- 24 by the commissioner.
- 25 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (1), REVENUE FROM THE SALE OF
- 26 LOTTERY TICKETS OR SHARES TO A SEPARATE LOTTERY GAME ESTABLISHED
- 27 UNDER SECTION 10 SHALL BE APPORTIONED FOR PAYMENT OF PRIZES AS

- 1 PROVIDED IN RULES PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER SECTION 10.
- 2 Sec. 33. (1) Unclaimed prize money for the prize on a winning
- 3 ticket or share of the state lottery shall be retained by the
- 4 commissioner for the person entitled to the prize money for 1 year
- 5 after the drawing in which the prize was won. If a claim is not
- 6 made for the prize money within the year, the prize money shall be
- 7 deposited in the state school aid fund and distributed pursuant to
- 8 law.
- 9 (2) Unclaimed prize money for the prize on a winning ticket or
- 10 share of any joint enterprise shall be treated in the manner
- 11 provided for in the joint enterprise participation agreement
- 12 executed by the commissioner. To the extent that the state of
- 13 Michigan is entitled to any unclaimed prize money, that money
- 14 received shall be deposited into the state school aid fund and
- 15 distributed pursuant to law.
- 16 (3) UNCLAIMED PRIZE MONEY FOR THE PRIZE ON A WINNING TICKET OR
- 17 SHARE OF A SEPARATE LOTTERY GAME ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 10 SHALL
- 18 BE RETAINED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR THE PERSON ENTITLED TO THE
- 19 PRIZE MONEY FOR 1 YEAR AFTER THE DRAWING IN WHICH THE PRIZE WAS
- 20 WON. IF A CLAIM IS NOT MADE FOR THE PRIZE MONEY WITHIN THE YEAR,
- 21 THE PRIZE MONEY SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE CITY LOTTERY FUND CREATED
- 22 IN SECTION 45.
- 23 Sec. 41. (1) The state lottery fund is created in the
- 24 department of treasury. Except as provided in SECTION 10 AND
- 25 subsection (3), the state lottery fund consists of all money
- 26 received from the sale of state lottery tickets or shares and all
- 27 other money credited or transferred to the fund from any other fund

- 1 or source pursuant to law including interest earnings on common
- 2 cash attributable to the state lottery fund. Money derived from the
- 3 sale of tickets or shares of any joint enterprise shall be treated
- 4 in the manner provided for in the joint enterprise participation
- 5 agreement executed by the commissioner. The commissioner shall
- 6 deposit net revenue from any joint enterprise in the state lottery
- 7 fund. Earnings resulting from installment payment of any lottery
- 8 prizes shall be used for payment of prizes to lottery winners and
- 9 the prize structure formulated pursuant to sections 11 and 12 shall
- 10 be established accordingly.
- 11 (2) The investment authority of the state treasurer with
- 12 regard to the state lottery fund is the same as his or her
- 13 investment authority with regard to retirement system funds. The
- 14 state treasurer may also invest all or part of the money in the
- 15 state lottery fund in obligations issued by this state pursuant to
- 16 section 14, 15, or 16 of article IX of the state constitution of
- 17 1963 if the treasurer determines that the obligations are full
- 18 faith and credit obligations of this state and provide a rate of
- 19 return at the time of investment that is not less than the rate of
- 20 return at the time of investment on United States treasury
- 21 obligations of comparable maturity. The state treasurer shall
- 22 comply with the divestment from terror act, 2008 PA 234, MCL
- 23 129.291 to 129.301, in making investments under this act. To assure
- 24 a continuing availability of money with which to pay state lottery
- 25 prize installments and to compensate for variations in the yield on
- 26 investments, every 6 months the commissioner and the state
- 27 treasurer shall review the status of the installment prize

- 1 investments and shall agree on an amount to be restricted out of
- 2 the total revenues of the state lottery fund as a reserve against a
- 3 drop in yield. If the commissioner and the state treasurer fail to
- 4 agree on the amount to be reserved, the matter shall be referred to
- 5 the state administrative board for a decision on the amount to be
- 6 reserved.
- 7 (3) Except as provided in subsection (4), after the payment of
- 8 prizes to the holders of winning state lottery tickets or shares or
- 9 the payment pursuant to UNDER section 32 of the liabilities to this
- 10 state of holders of winning state lottery tickets or shares, and
- 11 the payment of the reasonable expenses of the bureau in its
- 12 operation of the lottery, the net revenue in the state lottery fund
- 13 and any money or interest generated by the state lottery fund and
- 14 share of common cash shall be deposited in the state school aid
- 15 fund and shall be distributed as provided by law.
- 16 (4) Ten percent of each year's state lottery advertising
- 17 budget but not more than \$1,000,000.00 shall be deposited in the
- 18 compulsive gaming prevention fund created in section 3 of the
- 19 compulsive gaming prevention act, 1997 PA 70, MCL 432.253.
- 20 SEC. 45. (1) THE CITY LOTTERY FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
- 21 TREASURY.
- 22 (2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM
- 23 THE SALE OF TICKETS OR SHARES IN A SEPARATE LOTTERY GAME
- 24 ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 10 AND FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT
- 25 INTO THE CITY LOTTERY FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE
- 26 INVESTMENT OF THE CITY LOTTERY FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
- 27 CREDIT TO THE CITY LOTTERY FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM CITY

- 1 LOTTERY FUND INVESTMENTS.
- 2 (3) MONEY IN THE CITY LOTTERY FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL
- 3 YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE CITY LOTTERY FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO
- 4 THE GENERAL FUND.
- 5 (4) THE BUREAU SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CITY LOTTERY
- 6 FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.
- 7 (5) THE BUREAU SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE CITY LOTTERY FUND
- 8 AS FOLLOWS IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:
- 9 (A) FOR THE PAYMENT OF PRIZES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES
- 10 PROMULGATED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER SECTION 10.
- 11 (B) FOR PAYMENT UNDER SECTION 32 OF LIABILITIES TO THIS STATE
- 12 OF HOLDERS OF WINNING TICKETS OR SHARES IN THE SEPARATE LOTTERY
- 13 GAME ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 10.
- 14 (C) AS APPROPRIATED, FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE REASONABLE
- 15 EXPENSES OF THE BUREAU IN ITS OPERATION OF THE SEPARATE LOTTERY
- 16 GAME.
- 17 (D) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE BALANCE IN THE CITY
- 18 LOTTERY FUND TO CITIES IN THIS STATE WITH POPULATIONS OF 600,000 OR
- 19 MORE. IF MORE THAN 1 CITY IS ENTITLED TO DISTRIBUTION OF MONEY
- 20 UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION, THE MONEY SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED
- 21 PROPORTIONATELY ACCORDING TO POPULATION.
