HOUSE BILL No. 5829

August 15, 2012, Introduced by Rep. McMillin and referred to the Committee on Local, Intergovernmental, and Regional Affairs.

A bill to require public bodies to provide certain information to a municipality before installing a video surveillance camera in the municipality; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state and local governmental officers and entities.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "public body video surveillance camera disclosure act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Electronic information" means audio, video, or any other information recorded, collected, or otherwise obtained by a video surveillance camera.
 - (b) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or township of this state.

- 2 (i) A state officer, employee, agency, department, division,
- 3 bureau, board, commission, council, authority, or other body in the
- 4 executive branch of the state government.
- 5 (ii) An agency, board, commission, or council in the

- 7 (iii) An agency, board, commission, or council in the judicial
- 8 branch of state government.
- 9 (iv) A county, city, township, village, intercounty, intercity,
- 10 or regional governing body, council, school district, special

- (v) Any other body that is created by state or local authority

- 23 (b) The public body's purpose for installing the video

- 1 (e) The location where the electronic information is sent or
- 2 stored, or both.
- 3 (2) A public body that installs or maintains a video
- 4 surveillance camera within a municipality shall make the location
- 5 where the electronic information is sent or stored, or both,
- 6 available for inspection by the elected officials of the
- 7 municipality.
