- 1 SEC. 931C. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT PROMISE OR PROVIDE ANY
- 2 VALUABLE CONSIDERATION TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO RUN AS A CANDIDATE FOR
- 3 ELECTION TO A POLITICAL OFFICE.
- 4 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT ACCEPT ANY VALUABLE CONSIDERATION
- 5 FROM AN INDIVIDUAL TO RUN AS A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO A
- 6 POLITICAL OFFICE.
- 7 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 8 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
  - A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
