SENATE BILL No. 105

February 8, 2011, Introduced by Senators HUNTER, GLEASON, YOUNG, HOOD, SMITH and BIEDA and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill to establish the imagine fund in the department of treasury; to provide for the distribution of the money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "imagine fund act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the department of treasury.
 - (b) "Fund" means the imagine fund created in section 5.
 - Sec. 5. (1) The imagine fund is created in the department to provide funds for donation to the imagine fund scholarship program.
- The department shall be the administrator of the fund for auditing
- purposes.

- 1 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
- 2 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
- 3 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435, and money from any other
- 4 source for deposit into the fund.
- 5 (3) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the
- 6 fund. The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
