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## **SENATE BILL No. 151**

February 16, 2011, Introduced by Senator HANSEN and referred to the Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 81133 (MCL 324.81133), as amended by 2008 PA
365.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 81133. A person shall not operate an ORV:
- (a) At a rate of speed greater than is reasonable and proper,
  or in a careless manner having due regard for conditions then
  existing.
  - (b) Unless the person and any passenger in or on the vehicle is wearing on his or her head a crash helmet and protective eyewear approved by the United States department of transportation. This

THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS subdivision does DO not apply if the TO

## EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

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- 2 (i) THE OPERATOR OR A PASSENGER IN A vehicle THAT is equipped
- 3 with a roof that meets or exceeds standards for a crash helmet and
- 4 IF the operator and each passenger is ALL PASSENGERS ARE wearing a
- 5 properly adjusted and fastened safety belt BELTS.
- 6 (ii) THE OPERATOR OR A PASSENGER IN AN ORV THAT IS OPERATED ON
- 7 PRIVATE LAND AT A SPEED NOT GREATER THAN 25 MILES PER HOUR.
- 8 (c) During the hours of 1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour
- 9 before sunrise without displaying a lighted headlight and lighted
- 10 taillight. The requirements of this subdivision are in addition to
- 11 any applicable requirements of section 81131(8).
- 12 (d) Unless equipped with a braking system that may be operated
- 13 by hand or foot, capable of producing deceleration at 14 feet per
- 14 second on level ground at a speed of 20 miles per hour; a brake
- 15 light, brighter than the taillight, visible when the brake is
- 16 activated to the rear of the vehicle when the vehicle is operated
- 17 during the hours of 1/2 hour after sunset and 1/2 hour before
- 18 sunrise; and a throttle so designed that when the pressure used to
- 19 advance the throttle is removed, the engine speed will immediately
- 20 and automatically return to idle.
- 21 (e) In a state game area or state park or recreation area,
- 22 except on roads, trails, or areas designated for this purpose; on
- 23 state owned lands under the control of the department other than
- 24 game areas, state parks, or recreational areas where the operation
- 25 would be in violation of rules promulgated by the department; in a
- 26 forest nursery or planting area; on public lands posted or
- 27 reasonably identifiable as an area of forest reproduction, and when

- 1 growing stock may be damaged; in a dedicated natural area of the
- 2 department; or in any area in such a manner as to create an erosive
- 3 condition, or to injure, damage, or destroy trees or growing crops.
- 4 However, the department may permit an owner and guests of the owner
- 5 to use an ORV within the boundaries of a state forest in order to
- 6 access the owner's property.
- 7 (f) On the frozen surface of public waters within 100 feet of
- 8 a person not in or upon a vehicle, or within 100 feet of a fishing
- 9 shanty or shelter or an area that is cleared of snow for skating
- 10 purposes, except at the minimum speed required to maintain
- 11 controlled forward movement of the vehicle, or as may be authorized
- 12 by permit in special events.
- 13 (g) Unless the vehicle is equipped with a spark arrester type
- 14 United States forest service approved muffler, in good working
- 15 order and in constant operation. Exhaust noise emission shall not
- 16 exceed 86 Db(A) or 82 Db(A) on a vehicle manufactured after January
- 17 1, 1986, when the vehicle is under full throttle, traveling in
- 18 second gear, and measured 50 feet at right angles from the vehicle
- 19 path with a sound level meter that meets the requirement of ANSI
- 20 S1.4 1983, using procedure and ancillary equipment therein
- 21 described; or 99 Db(A) or 94 Db(A) on a vehicle manufactured after
- 22 January 1, 1986, or that level comparable to the current sound
- 23 level as provided for by the United States environmental protection
- 24 agency when tested according to the provisions of the current SAE
- 25 J1287, June 86 test procedure for exhaust levels of stationary
- 26 motorcycles, using sound level meters and ancillary equipment
- 27 therein described. A vehicle subject to this part, manufactured or

- 1 assembled after December 31, 1972 and used, sold, or offered for
- 2 sale in this state, shall conform to the noise emission levels
- 3 established by the United States environmental protection agency
- 4 under the noise control act of 1972, 42 USC 4901 to 4918.
- 5 (h) Within 100 feet of a dwelling at a speed greater than the
- 6 minimum required to maintain controlled forward movement of the
- 7 vehicle, except on property owned or under the operator's control
- 8 or on which the operator is an invited guest, or on a roadway,
- 9 forest road, or forest trail maintained by or under the
- 10 jurisdiction of the department, or on a road or street on which ORV
- 11 use is authorized pursuant to UNDER section 81131(2), (3), or (5).
- 12 (i) In or upon the lands of another without the written
- 13 consent of the owner, the owner's agent, or a lessee, when required
- 14 by part 731. The operator of the vehicle is liable for damage to
- 15 private property, including, but not limited to, damage to trees,
- 16 shrubs, or growing crops, injury to other living creatures, or
- 17 damage caused through vehicle operation in a manner so as to create
- 18 erosive or other ecological damage. The owner of the private
- 19 property may recover from the person responsible nominal damages of
- 20 not less than the amount of damage or injury. Failure to post
- 21 private property or fence or otherwise enclose in a manner to
- 22 exclude intruders or of the private property owner or other
- 23 authorized person to personally communicate against trespass does
- 24 not imply consent to ORV use.
- 25 (j) In an area on which public hunting is permitted during the
- 26 regular November firearm deer season from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. and
- 27 from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., except during an emergency or for law

- 1 enforcement purposes, to go to and from a permanent residence or a
- 2 hunting camp otherwise inaccessible by a conventional wheeled
- 3 vehicle, to remove from public land a deer, elk, or bear that has
- 4 been taken under a valid license; except for the conduct of
- 5 necessary work functions involving land and timber survey,
- 6 communication and transmission line patrol, and timber harvest
- 7 operations; or except on property owned or under control of the
- 8 operator or on which the operator is an invited guest. A hunter
- 9 removing game under this subdivision may leave the designated trail
- 10 or forest road only to retrieve the game and shall not exceed BUT
- 11 SHALL NOT OPERATE THE ORV AT A SPEED GREATER THAN 5 miles per hour.
- 12 A vehicle registered under the code is exempt from this subdivision
- 13 while operating on a public highway or public or private road
- 14 capable of sustaining automobile traffic. A person holding a valid
- 15 permit to hunt from a standing vehicle issued under part 401, or a
- 16 person with disabilities using an ORV to access public lands for
- 17 purposes of hunting or fishing through use of a designated trail or
- 18 forest road, is exempt from this subdivision. A person holding a
- 19 valid permit to hunt from a standing vehicle issued under part 401,
- 20 or a person with disabilities using an ORV to access public lands
- 21 for purposes of hunting or fishing, may display a flag, the color
- 22 of which the department shall determine, to identify himself or
- 23 herself as a person with disabilities or a person holding a permit
- 24 to hunt from a standing vehicle under part 401.
- 25 (k) While transporting on the vehicle a bow unless unstrung or
- 26 encased, or a firearm unless unloaded and securely encased, or
- 27 equipped with and made inoperative by a manufactured keylocked

- 1 trigger housing mechanism.
- 2 (1) On or across a cemetery or burial ground, or land used as
- 3 an airport.
- 4 (m) Within 100 feet of a slide, ski, or skating area, unless
- 5 the vehicle is being used for the purpose of servicing the area or
- 6 is being operated pursuant to UNDER section 81131(2), (3), or (5).
- 7 (n) On an operating or nonabandoned railroad or railroad
- 8 right-of-way, or public utility right-of-way, other than for the
- 9 purpose of crossing at a clearly established site intended for
- 10 vehicular traffic, except railroad, public utility, or law
- 11 enforcement personnel while in performance of their duties, and
- 12 except if the right-of-way is designated as provided for in section
- **13** 81127.
- (o) In or upon the waters of any stream, river, bog, wetland,
- 15 swamp, marsh, or quagmire except over a bridge, culvert, or similar
- 16 structure.
- 17 (p) To hunt, pursue, worry, kill, or attempt to hunt, pursue,
- 18 worry, or kill an animal, whether wild or domesticated.
- 19 (q) In a manner so as to leave behind litter or other debris.
- (r) In a manner contrary to operating regulations on public
- 21 lands.
- (s) While transporting or possessing, in or on the vehicle,
- 23 alcoholic liquor in a container that is open or uncapped or upon
- 24 which the seal is broken, except under either of the following
- 25 circumstances:
- 26 (i) The container is in a trunk or compartment separate from
- 27 the passenger compartment of the vehicle.

- $\mathbf{1}$  (ii) If the vehicle does not have a trunk or compartment
- 2 separate from the passenger compartment, the container is encased
- 3 or enclosed.
- 4 (t) While transporting any passenger in or upon an ORV unless
- 5 the manufacturing standards for the vehicle make provisions for
- 6 transporting passengers.
- 7 (u) On adjacent private land, in an area zoned residential,
- 8 within 300 feet of a dwelling at a speed greater than the minimum
- 9 required to maintain controlled forward movement of the vehicle
- 10 except on a roadway, forest road, or forest trail maintained by or
- 11 under the jurisdiction of the department, or on a road or street on
- 12 which ORV use is authorized pursuant to UNDER section 81131(2),
- **13** (3), or (5).
