## **SENATE BILL No. 462**

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 21771 (MCL 333.21771).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 21771. (1) A licensee, nursing home administrator, or employee of a nursing home shall not physically, mentally, or emotionally abuse, mistreat, or harmfully neglect a patient.

(2) A nursing home employee who becomes aware of an act prohibited by this section immediately shall IMMEDIATELY report the matter to the nursing home administrator or nursing director AND TO THE DEPARTMENT. A nursing home administrator or nursing director who becomes aware of an act prohibited by this section immediately shall IMMEDIATELY report the matter by telephone to the department. of public health, which in turn shall notify the department of
