SENATE BILL No. 498

June 16, 2011, Introduced by Senator HUNE and referred to the Committee on Redistricting.

A bill to amend 2001 PA 116, entitled

"An act to divide this state into 110 representative and 38 senatorial districts; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers,"

by amending the title and sections 3 and 6 (MCL 4.2003 and 4.2006) and by adding sections 1a, 2a, and 5a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to divide this state into 110 representative and 38 senatorial districts; TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers.

SEC. 1A. THIS STATE IS DIVIDED INTO 110 REPRESENTATIVE

DISTRICTS. FOR TERMS OF OFFICE BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1,

2013, THE DISTRICTS ARE CONSTITUTED AND NUMBERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 2 THE REST OF THE MUNICIPALITY IS SHIFTED TO ANOTHER DISTRICT, THERE
- 3 IS 1 BREAK.
- 4 (iv) IF THE BOUNDARY OF A CITY, WHICH IS LOCATED IN MORE THAN 1
- 5 COUNTY, IS BROKEN IN ORDER TO PRESERVE A COUNTY BOUNDARY, THAT DOES
- 6 NOT COUNT AS A MUNICIPAL BREAK.
- 7 (C) THE REDISTRICTING PLANS WERE DESIGNED TO COMPLY FULLY WITH
- 8 BOTH SECTION 2 OF THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT OF 1965, 42 USC 1973, AND
- 9 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE EQUAL PROTECTION CLAUSE OF AMENDMENT XIV OF
- 10 THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES. HOWEVER, THE PLANS DO NOT
- 11 SACRIFICE TRADITIONAL NEUTRAL PRINCIPLES, SUCH AS, MOST
- 12 IMPORTANTLY, THE MICHIGAN CONSTITUTIONAL PRINCIPLES OF PRESERVATION
- 13 OF COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENGAGING IN
- 14 A GERRYMANDER THAT UNNECESSARILY FAVORS 1 RACIAL GROUP OVER OTHERS.
- 15 (D) THE PLANS FURTHER THE UNDERLYING PURPOSE OF THE STATE
- 16 CONSTITUTION OF 1963 BY FACILITATING EFFECTIVE REPRESENTATION IN
- 17 THE LEGISLATURE WHERE ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES CAN ADVANCE THE
- 18 SHARED INTERESTS OF UNIFIED MUNICIPALITIES OR COUNTIES. THEY DO SO
- 19 WITHOUT SACRIFICING VOTING RIGHTS ACT OF 1965 PRINCIPLES, EQUAL
- 20 ELECTORAL OPPORTUNITIES, OR RACIAL FAIRNESS.
- 21 (E) THE REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 22 CONSISTS OF 110 SINGLE-MEMBER DISTRICTS COMPOSED OF CONVENIENT
- 23 TERRITORIES CONTIGUOUS BY LAND.
- 24 (F) THE REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE SENATE CONSISTS OF 38
- 25 SINGLE-MEMBER DISTRICTS COMPOSED OF CONVENIENT TERRITORIES
- 26 CONTIGUOUS BY LAND.
- Sec. 6. As used in this act:

- 1 (a) "Block" means block as that term is used by the United
- 2 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
- 3 the 2000-2010 decennial census.
- 4 (b) "Tract" means tract as that term is used by the United
- 5 States department of commerce, bureau of the census in conducting
- 6 the $\frac{2000}{2010}$ decennial census.

- **8** 4.2001 and 4.2002, are repealed.
