## SENATE BILL No. 574

August 24, 2011, Introduced by Senators BIEDA, ROCCA, WARREN, HOPGOOD, SMITH, JOHNSON, HANSEN and KOWALL and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 287, entitled

"An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; and to prescribe penalties and civil fines and to provide remedies,"

by amending the title and section 1 (MCL 287.331), as amended by 1997 PA 7, and by adding section 5b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; TO

REGULATE THE SALE OF DOGS AND CATS BY CERTAIN PERSONS; TO PROVIDE

CERTAIN PROTECTIONS FOR PURCHASERS OF DOGS AND CATS; and to

- 1 prescribe penalties and civil fines; and to provide remedies.
- 2 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 3 (a) "Adoption" means a transfer of ownership, with or without
- 4 remuneration, of a dog, cat, or ferret from an animal control
- 5 shelter or animal protection shelter to an individual for the
- 6 purpose of being a companion animal for that individual. As used in
- 7 this subdivision, a companion animal includes but is not limited to
- 8 a dog that is used for hunting or as a guard dog.
- 9 (b) "Alteration" means a professional sterilization procedure
- 10 performed by a veterinarian that renders a dog, cat, or ferret
- incapable of reproducing.
- 12 (c) "Altered", in reference to a dog, cat, or ferret, means
- 13 having undergone alteration.
- 14 (d) "Animal" means a mammal. except ANIMAL DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 15 livestock as defined in 1937 PA 284, MCL 287.121 to 287.131, and OR
- 16 rodents.
- 17 (e) "Animal control shelter" means a facility operated by a
- 18 municipality for the impoundment and care of animals that are found
- 19 in the streets or at large, animals that are otherwise held due to
- 20 the violation of a municipal ordinance or state law, or animals
- 21 that are surrendered to the animal control shelter.
- (f) "Animal protection shelter" means a facility operated by a
- 23 person, humane society, society for the prevention of cruelty to
- 24 animals, or any other nonprofit organization for the care of
- 25 homeless animals.
- 26 (G) "BREEDER" MEANS A PERSON WHO BREEDS OR RAISES DOGS OR CATS
- 27 FOR SALE TO THE PUBLIC.

- 1 (H) (g) "Cat" means a domestic cat ANIMAL of any age of the
- 2 species felis catus.
- 3 (I) (h) "Department" means the state department of agriculture
- 4 AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT.
- 5 (J) (i) "Director" means the director of the department or his
- 6 or her authorized representative.
- 7 (K) (j) "Dog" means a domestic dog ANIMAL of any age of the
- 8 species canis familiaris.
- 9 (1) (k) "Ferret" means an animal of any age of the species
- 10 mustela furo.
- 11 (M) (l)—"Health certificate" means a certificate in a form
- 12 prescribed by the department in which a veterinarian attests to the
- 13 age, sex, breed, and description of an animal, and to the fact that
- 14 at the time of preparation of the certificate, the veterinarian
- 15 examined the animal and found the animal free from visual evidence
- 16 of communicable disease.
- 17 (N) (m) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or
- 18 township.
- 19 (O) (n)—"Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 20 corporation, association, governmental entity, or other legal
- 21 entity.
- (P) "PET DEALER" MEANS A PERSON WHO FOR COMPENSATION BUYS OR
- 23 SELLS DOGS OR CATS. PET DEALER DOES NOT INCLUDE AN ANIMAL
- 24 PROTECTION SHELTER.
- 25 (Q) <del>(o)</del> "Pet shop" means a place where animals are sold or
- 26 offered for sale, exchange, or transfer.
- 27 (R) (p) "Veterinarian" means a person AN INDIVIDUAL licensed

- 1 to practice veterinary medicine under article 15 of the public
- 2 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16101 to 333.18838.
- 3 SEC. 5B. (1) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (A) A PET SHOP THAT SELLS DOGS OR CATS.
- 5 (B) A PET DEALER.
- 6 (C) A BREEDER.
- 7 (D) A PERSON WHO ENGAGES IN THE SALE OF DOGS OR CATS TO THE
- 8 PUBLIC FOR PROFIT.
- 9 (E) A PERSON WHO SELLS MORE THAN 1 LITTER OF DOGS OR CATS
- 10 UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE OR 2 DOGS OR CATS OVER 6 MONTHS OF AGE PER
- 11 YEAR.
- 12 (2) A DOG OR CAT IS UNFIT FOR SALE AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE IF
- 13 ANY OF THE FOLLOWING OCCUR:
- 14 (A) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER A PURCHASER RECEIVES THE DOG OR CAT
- 15 FROM A PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1), A VETERINARIAN STATES,
- 16 IN WRITING, THAT THE DOG OR CAT HAS SYMPTOMS OF A CONTAGIOUS OR
- 17 INFECTIOUS DISEASE OR ILLNESS THAT EXISTED IN THE DOG OR CAT AT THE
- 18 TIME OF PURCHASE.
- 19 (B) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER A PURCHASER RECEIVES THE DOG OR CAT
- 20 FROM A PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1), A VETERINARIAN STATES,
- 21 IN WRITING, THAT THE DOG OR CAT DIED OR IS ILL DUE TO A HEREDITARY
- 22 OR CONGENITAL DEFECT.
- 23 (3) IF A DOG OR CAT IS UNFIT FOR SALE AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE
- 24 AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION
- 25 (1) THAT SOLD THE DOG OR CAT TO THE PURCHASER SHALL ALLOW THE
- 26 PURCHASER OF THE DOG OR CAT TO DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 27 (A) RETURN THE DOG OR CAT FOR A REFUND OF THE FULL PURCHASE

- 2 (B) IF A REPLACEMENT DOG OR CAT IS AVAILABLE, EXCHANGE THE DOG
- 3 OR CAT FOR ANOTHER DOG OR CAT OF THE PURCHASER'S CHOICE THAT IS OF
- 4 EQUAL VALUE.
- 5 (C) RETAIN THE DOG OR CAT AND RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR
- 6 REASONABLE VETERINARY FEES. THE REIMBURSEMENT OF REASONABLE
- 7 VETERINARY FEES SHALL NOT EXCEED THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE PRICE OF THE
- 8 DOG OR CAT.
- 9 (D) IF THE DOG OR CAT DIES, RECEIVE ANOTHER DOG OR CAT OF
- 10 EQUAL VALUE, IF AVAILABLE, AND RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR REASONABLE
- 11 VETERINARY FEES. THE REIMBURSEMENT OF REASONABLE VETERINARY FEES
- 12 SHALL NOT EXCEED THE ORIGINAL PURCHASE PRICE OF THE DOG OR CAT.
- 13 (E) IF THE DOG OR CAT DIES, RECEIVE A REFUND OF THE FULL
- 14 PURCHASE PRICE.
- 15 (4) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT THE RIGHTS OR REMEDIES
- 16 OTHERWISE AVAILABLE TO THE PURCHASER OF A DOG OR CAT UNDER ANY
- 17 OTHER LAW.
