THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 301. The EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ACT, THE
- 2 court of appeals consists of 28 judges and is a court of record.
- 3 Sec. 302. The state is divided into 4 judicial districts for
- 4 the election of judges of the court of appeals. Each district is
- 5 entitled to 7 judges. The districts are constituted and numbered as
- 6 follows:
 - (a) District 1. consists of the counties of Calhoun,
 - Hillsdale, Lenawee, Monroe, and Wayne.

- (b) District 2. consists of the counties of Genesee, Macomb,
 Oakland, and Shiawassee.
- 3 (c) District 3. consists of the counties of Allegan, Barry,

- 5 Muskegon, Newaygo, Ottawa, St. Joseph, Van Buren, and Washtenaw.
- 6 (d) District 4. consists of the counties of Alcona, Alger,
- 7 Alpena, Antrim, Arenac, Baraga, Bay, Benzie, Charlevoix, Cheboygan,
- 8 Chippewa, Clare, Clinton, Crawford, Delta, Dickinson, Emmet,
- 9 Gladwin, Gogebic, Grand Traverse, Gratiot, Houghton, Huron, Ingham,
- 10 Iosco, Iron, Isabella, Kalkaska, Keweenaw, Lake, Lapeer, Leelanau,
- 11 Livingston, Luce, Mackinac, Manistee, Marquette, Mason, Mecosta,
- 12 Menominee, Midland, Missaukee, Montcalm, Montmorency, Oceana,
- 13 Ogemaw, Ontonagon, Osceola, Osceola, Otsego, Presque Isle,
