## **SENATE BILL No. 916**

January 26, 2012, Introduced by Senator KOWALL and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1951 PA 35, entitled

"An act to authorize intergovernmental contracts between municipal corporations; to authorize any municipal corporation to contract with any person or any municipal corporation to furnish any lawful municipal service to property outside the corporate limits of the first municipal corporation for a consideration; to prescribe certain penalties; to authorize contracts between municipal corporations and with certain nonprofit public transportation corporations to form group self-insurance pools; and to prescribe conditions for the performance of those contracts,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 124.1), as amended by 1996 PA 289.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. As used in this act:

(a) "Municipal corporation" means a county, charter county, county road commission, township, charter township, city, village, school district, intermediate school district, community college district, metropolitan district, court district, public authority, or drainage district as defined in the drain code of 1956, Act No.

40 of the Public Acts of 1956, being sections 1956 PA 40, MCL 280.1
